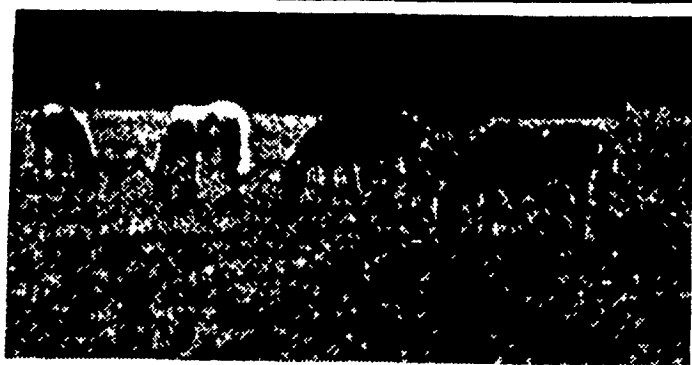


Changes In Farming

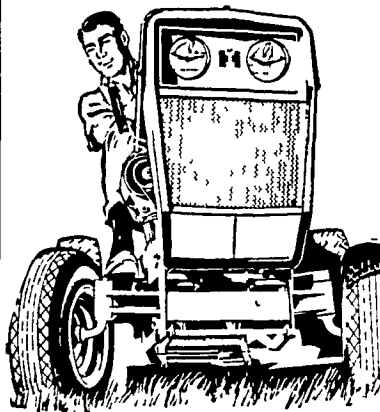

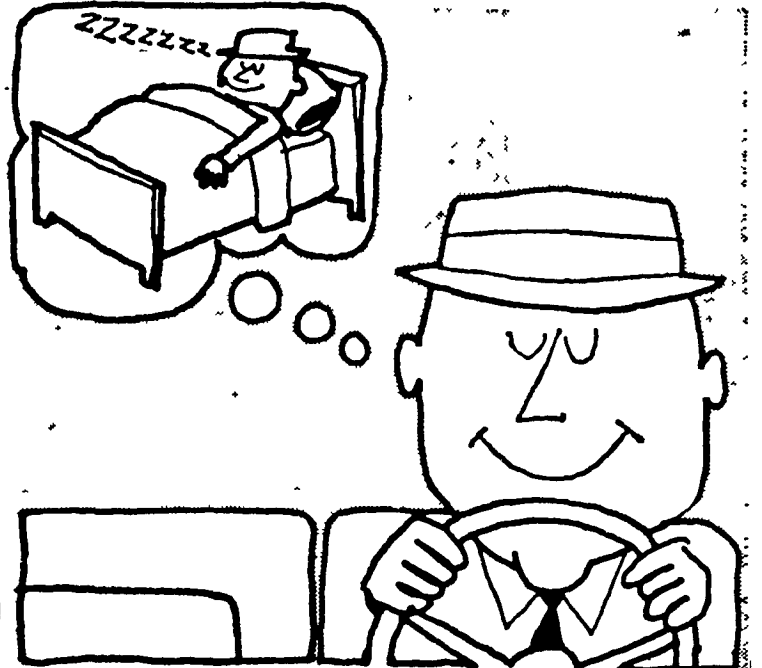

Healthy Grass

A stand of healthy grass in a lawn is one of the best preventatives against disease, dry weather, insect infestation, and weeds. One method of attaining this kind of turf is to lime and fertilize when needed. A complete soil test is the best way of learning this need. Few lawns will need lime every year but all grass will respond to fertilizer at least once a year. Early

spring is a good time to make this application. A complete fertilizer containing part of the nitrogen in the slow-available form should be used this spring if none was applied last fall. Straight grass stands can utilize only nitrogen fertilizer if the test reveals sufficient phosphorus and potash in the soil. Start now to have a good lawn later this summer.

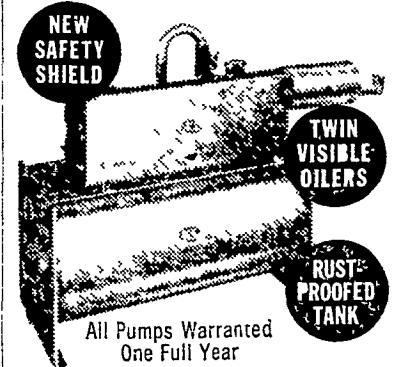
