saw many ways to renovate and decorate kitchens. The stop also featured a demonstration of a special new type of cook stove. However, their fears were ungrounded because the management of Quaker Maid reported they had been or-

ders to keep any new orders waiting until December. The plant has six acres under roof and produces 2,000 kitchen cabinets each week. The last six-year herd average is

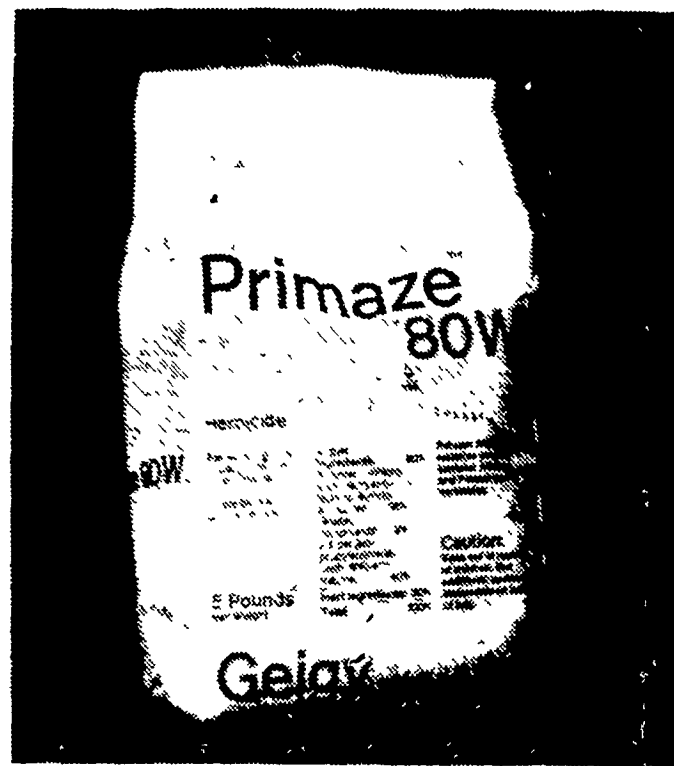

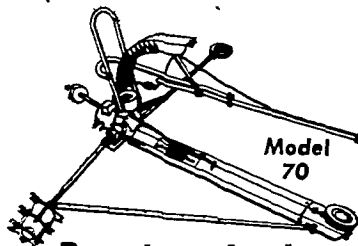

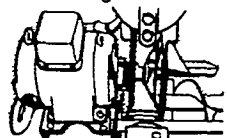
