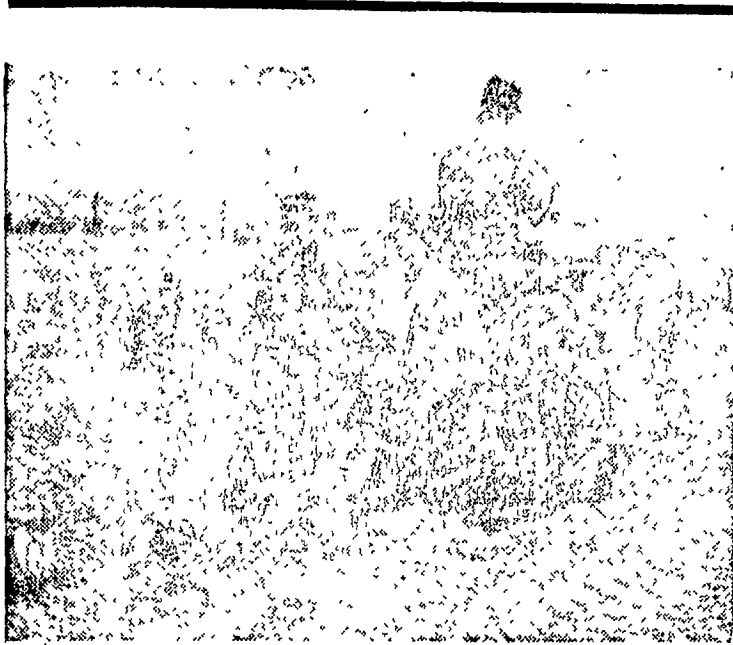

Fewer Package Sizes

Some food manufacturers have agreed to reduce the number of different package sizes, says Harold Neigh, Penn State extension consumer economics specialist. As of January 1, 1969, breakfast cereal is to be packaged in whole ounces, except for individual servings, and the number of package sizes reduced from 33 to 16. Cookie and cracker manufacturers are reducing the number of package sizes from 73 to 56. Many other food manufacturers also plan to reduce the number of package sizes for their products.
