## 44th Dairy Exposition April 28-May 10 At PSU

The 44th Annual Dairy Exposition at The Pennsylvania State University will be sponsored by the Penn State Dairy Science Club from April 28 to May 10 at the University Park Campus. The Exposition includes five major events — ice cream sculpturing, dairy products judging, dairy princess contest, dairy cattle judging, and fitting and showing contests.

The ice cream sculpturing contest will run from April 28 to May 9. Winning molds will be on display in the University Creamery. The dairy products judging and dairy princess contests will be held April 30 at 7:30 p.m. in Borland Laboratory. A milk "chugging" contest will also be held at this time.

On May 3, at 12:30 p.m., the dairy cattle judging contest will be held at the University Dairy Barns. Interested members of 4-H and FFA clubs will gain valuable experience by entering this contest.

The Exposition will be climaxed by the fitting and showing contest at the Dairy Barns on May 10 starting at 9 a.m. During this event, raffles will be held for a prize dairy calf and dairy products. At noon a calf dressing contest will also be held.

Following the Exposition on May 10 there will be an awards banquet at the Pine Grove Mills Elementary School at 6:30 p.m. At this time, many valuable prizes will be presented to the various Exposition winners.
