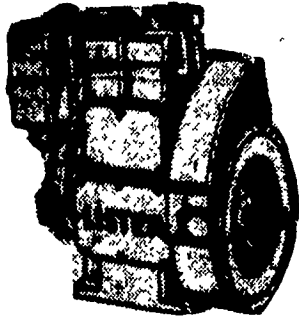

**52nd Little International
April 26 At Penn State**

It is that time of year again for the Little International at The Pennsylvania State University. The Little International is a livestock show organized and presented by the Penn State students of the Block and Bridle Club.

This year's 52nd show will be held on April 26 in the University Ice Skating Pavilion. Here students compete in showmanship and grooming of Penn State's beef cattle, horses, swine and sheep.

About four weeks before the show the students start to work with and train their animals. Chosen by lot. Course credit is not offered for this work, but the experience and practical knowledge is considered of great value — especially for students in animal industry.

The men who will judge the ability of students to fit and show their animals are, in beef cattle, Thomas Williams of Bradmar Angus in Colmar, Ill.; in horses, Robert Vallance, presently a veterinary student at the University of Pennsylvania, in sheep, Thomas Colvert, associate county agent in Somerset County; and in swine, Nevin

Zerbe, a swine producer in Centre County.

The days events begin with sheep and beef cattle judging at 8 a.m. followed by swine judging at 10 a.m. A sheep dressing contest will take place after the swine judging. At 1 p.m. the horse judging will begin, followed by the judging of the champion showman of all events.

After a busy morning and afternoon, there will be an evening banquet in the Hetzel Union Building where the students will receive their prizes. Leland H. Bull, State Secretary of Agriculture, will be honored at the banquet as the year's outstanding alumnus. Dr. Thomas L. Merritt, associate professor of animal science, to whom the show is dedicated, will also be honored. Both men were selected for their contributions to the animal industry.

Pennsylvania's commercial slaughterhouses turned out 83,675,000 pounds of red meat in February. This was 15 percent less than January production and 4 percent less than February a year ago. Part of the decline was attributed to fewer slaughtering days in February, according to the State Crop Reporting Service. Commercial meat production excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

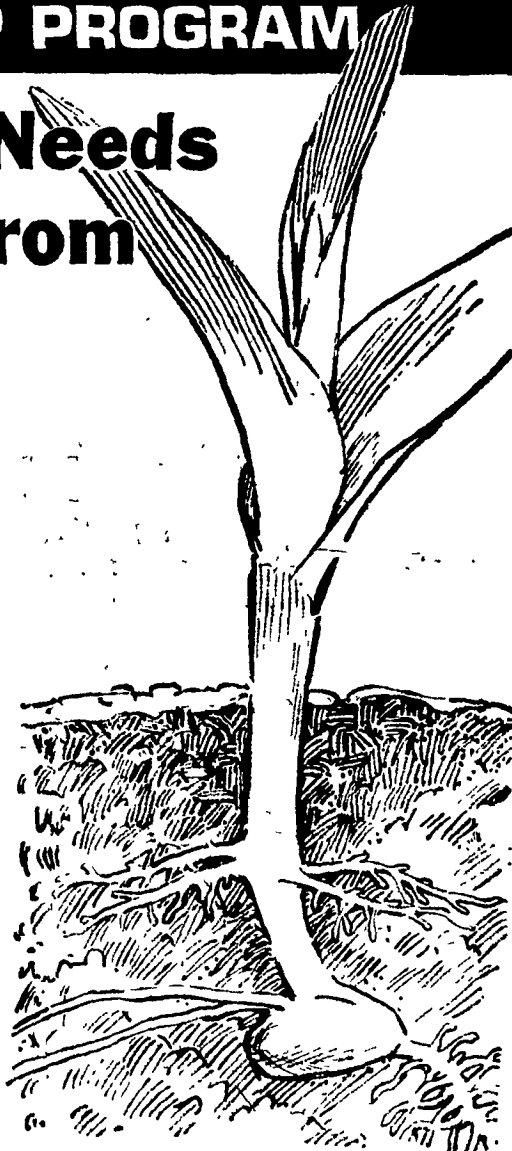

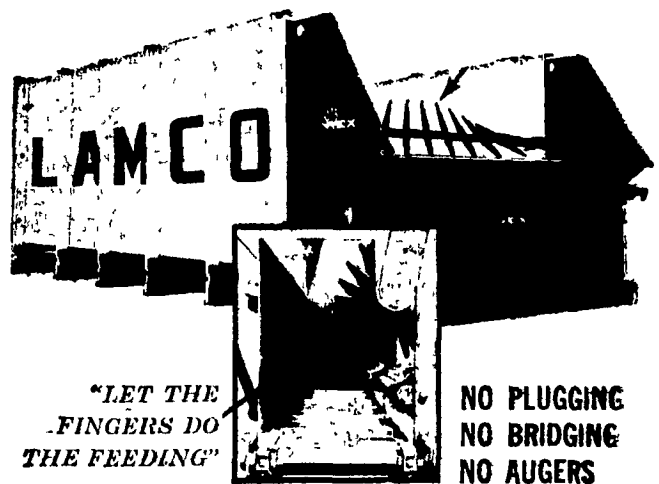
