Add egg to yeast mixture and beat until blended; then combine all ingredients. Knead on lightly floured board until smooth and elastic. Place in greased bowl; cover and let rise in a warm place (80 to 85 degrees) until double in size. Punch down. With lightly floured hands, form into 1-inch balls. Dip in remaining butter or margarine, melted. Place 3 balls in each of 18 greased muffin-pan cups, with balls touching bottom. Let rise until doubled in size. Bake in a preheated hot oven (400 degrees) 18 to 20 minutes, or until done. Sieve warm. Makes 18 rolls.

CHEDDAR WHOLE WHEAT BREAD

- 1 1/2 cups sifted regular all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 cups (8 ounces) shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1 1/4 cups whole wheat flour
- 1 cup chopped nuts
- 1 tablespoon grated orange peel

Avoid Error On Income Tax Return

The following are common mistakes which can cause a delay in a refund that's due. And they are more apt to occur if you fill out your form in a hurry because you've waited till the last minute to file your return.

Use of the wrong tax table or tax rate schedule.

Calculation from the wrong line of the tax table or tax rate schedule.

Incorrect or omitted social security number.

Failure to sign the return by either or both the husband and wife in a joint return.

Simple mistakes in adding, subtracting, or multiplication.

Failure to attach a W-2 form which shows earnings and withheld taxes.

No explanation for claiming dependents other than children.

Entry on the wrong line of 1099 forms if you take proper precautions.

Failure to compute the tax.

No explanatory statement for unusual deductions.

Tips On Storing Winter Clothes

Caring for clothes with each change of season will give you longer wear from each garment in your wardrobe.

Launder or dryclean garments you plan to store.

Have furs cleaned and stored professionally.

You can store garments at

If hanging space is available, garments other than knits can be stored on hangers, rather than being in a box.

Don't use plastic hangers or store clothes in plastic bags if you use moth balls, flakes, or crystals. Plastic may soften and harm the fabric.

Wash and store washable garments without pressing them.

Avoid use of starch on garments.

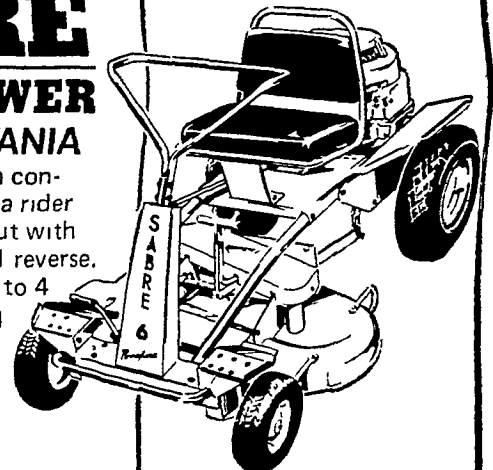
