Dr. Herrell DeGraff said beef cattle yields alone nearly doubl ed within the last 20 years From an average yield of 60 pounds of beef per person 20 years ago the beef industry now produces an average of 108 pounds per person

While the cow numbers are the same — 50 million — tre mendous improvements have been achieved in feeding breed ing and management to provide more meat

From the standpoint of grain, crops alone this nation of 200 million people could feed over 400 million people in terms of calorie output he stated

Looking ahead Di DeGraff! said the per capita demand for beef will reach about 130 pounds per person in the United States by the year 1980. At that time the nation will need an other one million breeding cows beef for the country's demands he predicted
