Warmer weather indicates
 time for many farm chores and
 one of these is to shear the flock
 of sheep Lancaster County
 ranks third in the state in the
 number of sheep so local pro-
 ducers should give some atten-
 tion to a good wool clip at this
 time Too many growers permit
 the sheep to curly their wool
 too late into the spring there is
 little to be gained from this
 practice Two sheared early
 will make better Mothers and
 respond more favorably to incle-
 ment weather conditions When
 the weather gets too warm
 many of the animals will begin
 to rub and loosen some of the
 wool fibers Sheep should be
 sheared when dry and the wool
 tied with paper twine and plac-
 ed in a clean dry place until
 sold
