Local receipts 75 percent slaughter steers, 20 percent heifers balance mainly cows Overall finish of slaughter steers 10 percent prime and 76 percent choice This compares with 11 percent prime and 78 percent choice last week, and 9 percent prime and 75 percent choice a year ago Average cost and weight of slaughter steers, estimated at 30 35 and 1150 lbs, compared with 30 91 and 1160 lbs last week, and 27 42 and 1152 lbs a year ago Heifer supply mainly high good to low prime weighing 850 1050 lbs
