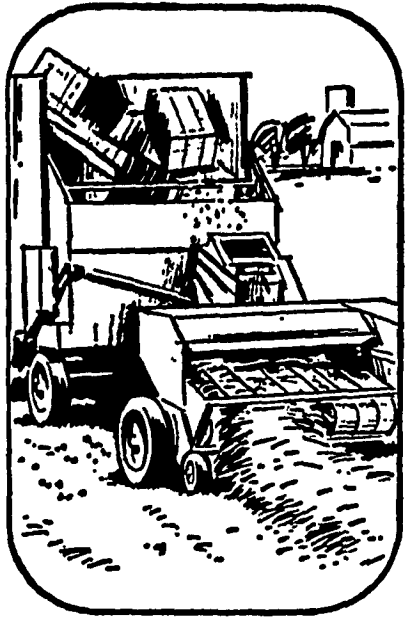

Wild Flowers Honey & Fruit Featured At Annual Meeting

Now there's a honey product for people who don't like honey. It's a creamed honey-dried fruit combination developed by researchers at Penn State. In taste tests, eight out of ten honey-haters said they liked the new spread. Honey-lovers also liked it.

The fruit spread is seen as a way to shore up, even reverse, a downward trend in per capita honey consumption in this country. It also may aid export sales.

Digging into reasons why

some people don't buy honey, researchers Robert Berthold, Jr., and Allen W. Benton uncovered such objections as "too sweet," "lacks flavor" and even "too messy."

Their answer was to blend chopped fruit with honey in a non-runny, creamed form. Sun-dried apricots and freeze-dried strawberries proved to be particularly adaptable.

After they had gone as far as they could in the lab, the researchers contacted Dutch Gold Honey, Inc., of Lancaster, the state's largest honey packer, to test commercial manufacturing feasibility.

W. Ralph Gamber, president of Dutch Gold, found no serious

problems utilizing available commercial production equipment.

In test-marketing in stores at State College, the honey-fruit spreads out-sold similar-sized containers or standard honey.

Dutch Gold has gone into regular production of the new spreads.

Jerome W. Doner Co., Bala Cynwyd, which handles exports for Dutch Gold, has found an acceptance of the new spreads in Europe and plans to do market testing in Japan. Biggest export markets for U.S. honey are West Germany, France, United Kingdom, Canada, Netherlands and Japan. Honey consumption in Japan has increased sharply in recent years

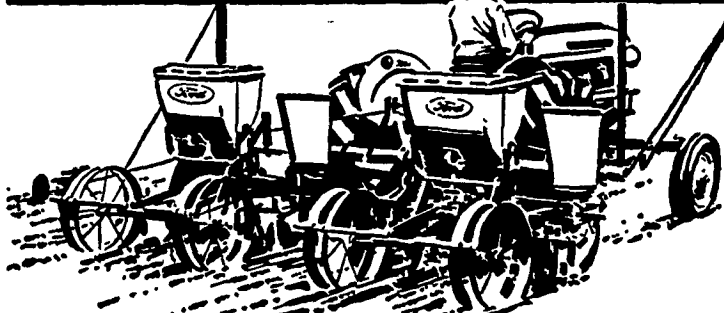

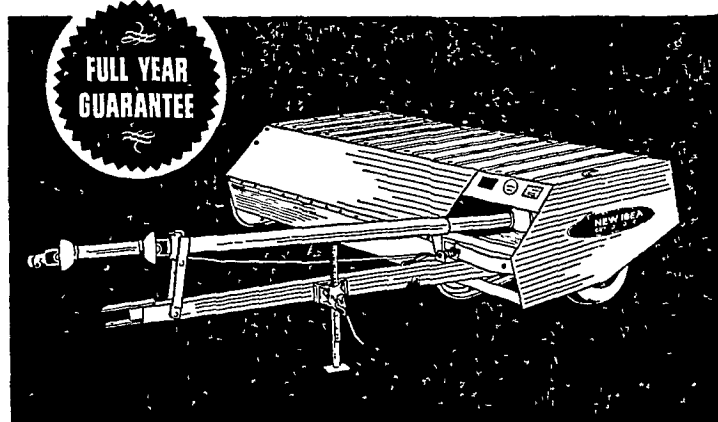
