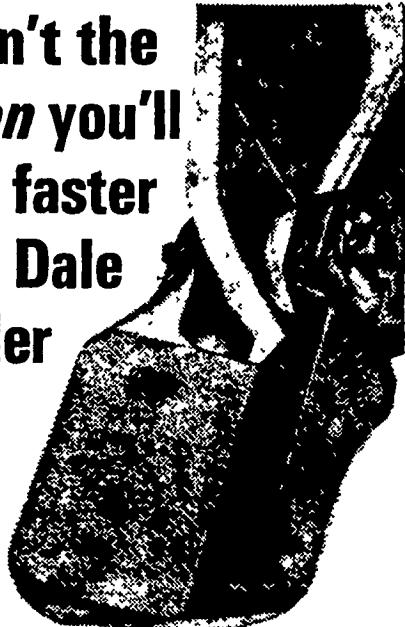

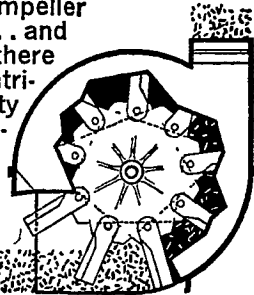

Pesticides

The proper handling of pesticides is the big problem confronting agriculture today; it's not the materials themselves but the people handling the chemicals that are responsible. This same thing is true with automobiles and firearms; it's not the machinery or equipment that causes the accidents, it's the operator handling the mechanism. Therefore, all gardeners and farmers are again reminded to be extremely careful in the use and storage of all types of spray materials. Read the instructions on the label and follow them accurately; this is the best advice that can be given. Prevent human error by practicing sincere and thorough pesticide safety.

Orchard Grass

Pennmead orchardgrass is proving to be the best yielding orchardgrass for the northeast; this new variety is of medium maturity date, between Potomac and Pennlate, and well suited for use with early maturing Flemish alfalfa varieties such as Saranac; it is an excellent companion grass for these alfalfa varieties. The yield advantage in Pennmead comes mainly from the aftermath cuttings; the first cutting compares to the other better orchardgrass varieties.
