Grape Leaflet Receives Wide Distribution

Farm Bureau's new leaflet, The Truth About the Grape Boycott, has received wide distribution since its publication in mid-April.

Among the news media receiving copies are the editorial writers of U.S. daily newspapers, farm magazine editors, farm editors of daily newspapers, and the radio farm directors.

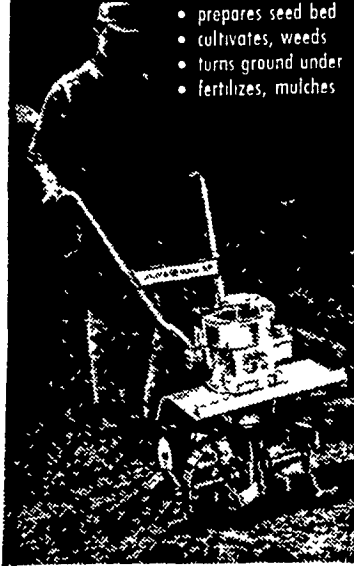
In addition, others receiving the leaflet include U.S. Congressmen and Executive officers; agricultural opinion makers, such as county agents, state extension directors, home demonstration agents, and 4-H leaders; municipal officers; trade association leaders; business leaders, and religious leaders

These first mailings total approximately 24,000 copies.

A second run of 25,000 has just come off the press and is available for State Farm Bureaus, who have already received sample copies of the leaflet. HOW TO HAVE A BETTER LAWN... IN 25 WEEDS OR LESS!

Gardeners trying to cope with the problems of weeds need not be "for-lawn". There are several modern ways of weeding out the unwelcome. The Antrol Lawn Research Bureau lists 25 weeds in three major groups and recommends controls for each.

Common among garden "gangsters," broadleaf weeds include the Dock, Dandelion, Plantain, Yarrow, Purslane,



Wild Onion, Shepherd's Purse and Buckhorn. Because these varieties tend to be easy targets, the most economical control is a "squirt"-type killer such as Squeeze 'N Weed.

Viney weeds—those that spread by root runners—create



a net over a lawn, literally choking out good grass. To kill these weeds—chickweed, ground ivy, henbit, bur clover and their relatives—a weed

killer that sprays a fine mist in a wide patch is essential. Normal 1-shot aerosols and granular weed killer only kill a section of the weed root, and the weed promptly recovers and continues to spread. Specifically a wide stream aerosol chickweed killer is recommended.

By themselves are the summertime grassy weeds—crabgrass and its many relatives including goosegrass, barnyard grass, foxtail, quackgrass and orchard grass. The sooner after



the forsythia blossom fades they are sprayed—the easier it is to get total kill. Still 2 sprayings with a new aerosol jet stream crabgrass killer—10 days apart are needed.

Cleverly, the tick deadens the skin with its saliva so that you cannot feel it insert its mouth parts and inflate two "projections" with its own body fluids.

When the mite infests the back of the neck of children, a paralytic reaction of the central nervous system can occur. The bite

can be fatal unless the tick is removed immediately. When the tick is out, the paralysis will disappear within an hour.

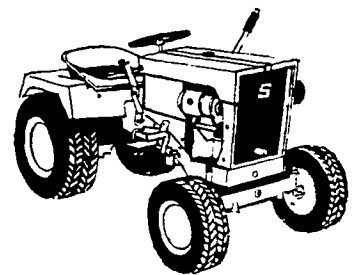
You can prevent the attack of ticks by sprinkling flea powder on your dog and using an insect repellent or powderer sulfur on your ankles and legs before you go outdoors.

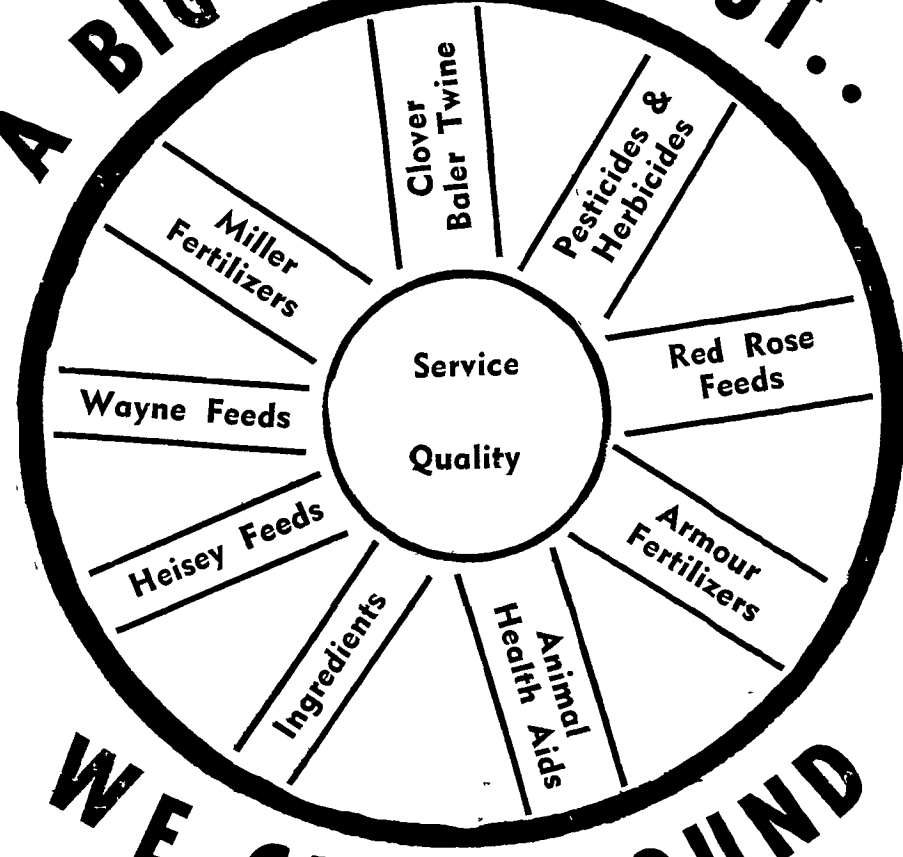
Tiny ticks are in season now through October
