and cheese Season Place in greased casserole and top with buttered bread crumbs Bake at 375 degrees for 25 minutes.

CRANBERRY-PINEAPPLE SALAD
2 pks. lemon-lime gelatin
1 cup hot water
Cool. Then add:
1 7 oz. bottle gingerale
1 can jellied cranberry (mashed)
1 can crushed pineapple
Pour into 9x13 oblong pan. Cool until firm. Frost with this topping:

1 cup whipping cream (whipped)
1 8 oz. pk. cream cheese
¼ cup mayonnaise
Top by sprinkling chopped toasted pecans.

FILLED CUPCAKES
1½ cup flour
½ cup cocoa
1 cup sugar
1 teaspoon soda
½ teaspoon salt
1 egg
1 cup sour milk or buttermilk
½ cup melted shortening or oil
1 teaspoon vanilla
Sift together dry ingredients
Make a hollow in mixture; add

remaining ingredients. Beat until well blended. Fill cupcake papers. Bake at 325 degrees about 15 minutes

When cool, fill with a cookie press (using a #31 or #33 tip). Use your favorite frosting recipe, made of 10X sugar Cupcakes may also be frosted on top.

HOT FUDGE SAUCE FOR ICE CREAM

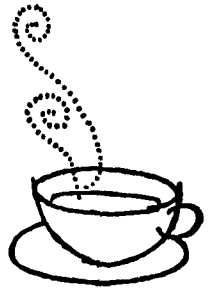
6 teaspoons cocoa
1 cup sugar
Pinch of salt
2 tablespoons cornstarch
1½ cup boiling water
½ teaspoon vanilla
1 tablespoon butter

Combine cocoa, sugar, salt and cornstarch Add boiling water. Cook in double boiler until thick Add vanilla and butter. Yield 1½ cups.

sect sprays weed killers, and fertilizers may help plants but they can kill people and animals. Store them out of reach, behind locked doors

Label everything

When applying insecticides, keep preparations away from eyes, nose, mouth, and skin.

Keep medicine and chemicals in locked cabinets, out of children's reach

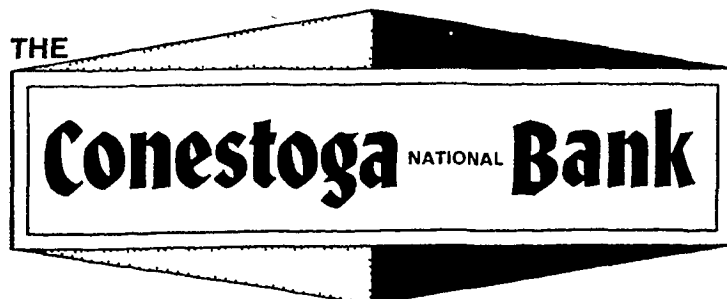

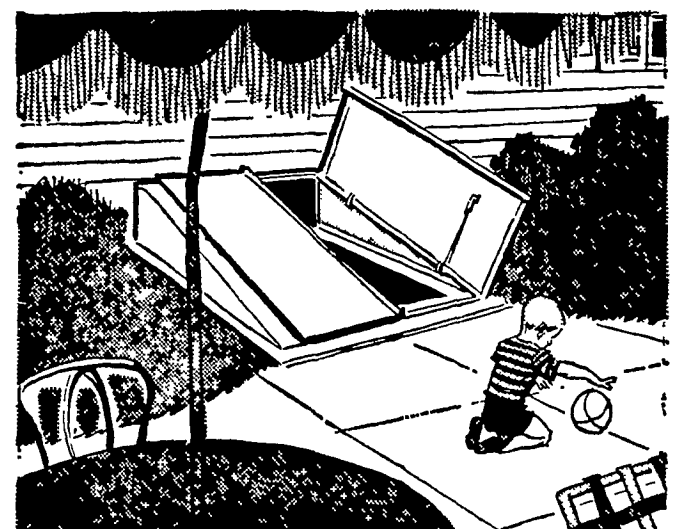
