WASHINGTON, D C — The nation's farm labor force totaled 3,995,800 workers during March 23-29. That's down 5 pct. from the March 1968 total, 42 pct below the March 1957-59 average. Meanwhile, farm wage rates continued to rise. The cash rate per hour without room or board averaged \$1.59 as of April 1. That's 11 pct above (the \$1.44) a year earlier, 77 pct. above the 1957-59 April 1 average

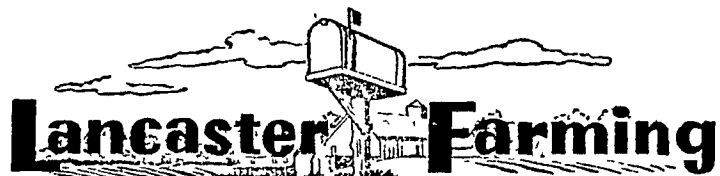
