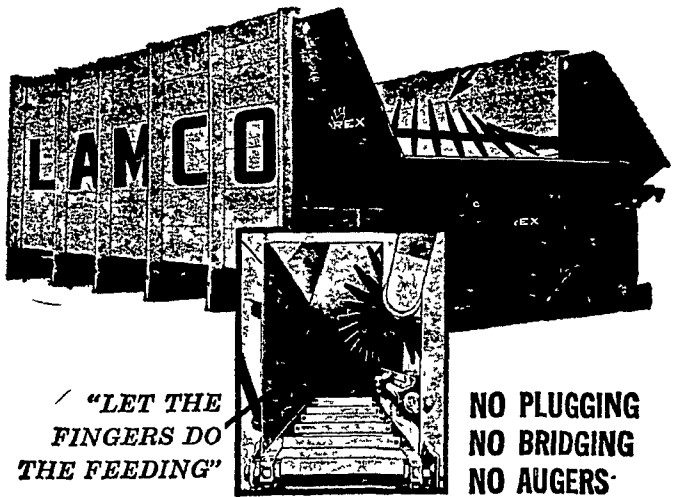

FUDGE RIBBON CAKE

- 2 tablespoons plus ½ cup soft butter
- 8 oz. cream cheese
- 2¼ cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- 3 eggs
- 3 tablespoons plus 1½ cup milk
- 1½ teaspoons vanilla
- 2 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon soda
- 4 envelopes (4 oz.) pre-melted unsweetened chocolate

Combine in small bowl 2 tablespoons butter, cream cheese, ¼ cup sugar, cornstarch, 1 egg 3 tablespoons milk and ½ teaspoon vanilla Beat till smooth. Combine remaining ingredients in large bowl Beat 4 minutes. Spread ½ of batter in pan. Spoon cheese mixture over top. Cover with remaining batter Use a 13" x 9" pan and bake 50 to 60 minutes at 350 degrees

CHOCOLATE FROSTING

- ½ cup milk
 - ¼ soft butter
 - 2 envelopes unsweetened chocolate
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla
 - 1½ cup 10x sugar
- Beat till smooth.

CINNAMON ROLLS

- ¾ cup warm water
- 1 package of yeast
- ¼ cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2¼ cups flour
- 1 egg
- ¼ cup soft butter

Dissolve yeast in water Add sugar, salt and half of the flour Beat well Add egg, shortening and remaining flour Let rise Shape and rise again Line 9" square pan with mixture of butter and brown sugar (about 2 tablespoons butter and ¼ cup brown sugar) Divide batter and roll out as for jelly roll, spread with soft butter and sugar and cinnamon Roll and cut Put into pan and let rise Bake at 425 degrees for about 20 minutes

MERINGUE SHELLS WITH STRAWBERRIES

- 6 egg whites
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon cream of tartar
- 1½ cup sugar
- ½ teaspoon vanilla

Beat egg whites, add salt and cream of tartar Add sugar gradually and vanilla Beat until dry. This is the secret of good meringues. Put 2 tablespoons on brown paper on cookie sheet and shape into a nest Bake in 250 degree oven 1 hour. May be made a day or more in advance and kept in air-tight containers in refrigerator or freezer These must be kept free of dampness. Fill with fresh strawberries or strawberries and ice cream This makes a pretty and very delicious dessert

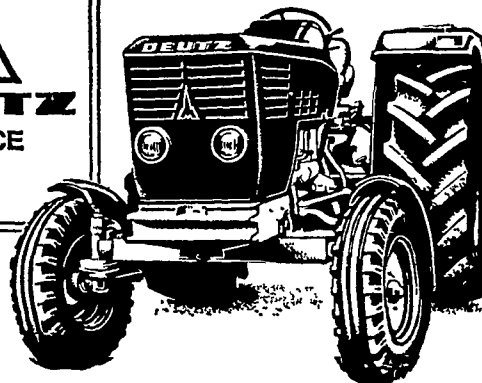

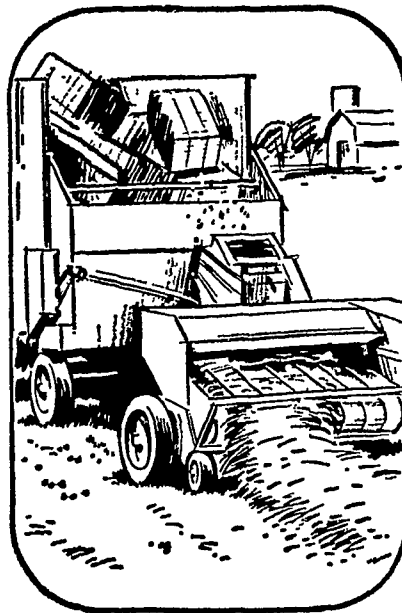
