FUDGE RIBBON CAKE tablespoons plus 12 cup soft butter

oz. cream cheese

- tablespoon cornstarch
- eggs
 - tablespoons plus 11/3 cup milk

 - cups flour
 - teaspoon salt
 - teaspoon baking powder
 - ½ teaspoon soda
 - envelops (4 oz.) pre-melted unsweetened chocolate

Combine in small bowl 2 tablespoons butter, cream cheese, 1/4 cup sugai, coinstaich, 1 egg 3 tiblespoons milk and 1/2 teaspoon vanilla Beat till smooth. Combine remaining ingredients in large bowl Beat 4 minutes. Spiead ½ of batter in pan. Spoon cheese mixture over top. Cover with remaining batter Use a 13" x 9" pan and bake 50 to 60 minutes at 350 degrees

CHOCOLATE FROSTING

¹/₃ cup milk 1/4 soft butter

- envelopes unsweetened chocolate
- teaspoon vanilla 1
- 1½ cup 10x sugar Beat till smooth.
 - CINNAMON ROLLS
- 3/4 cup warm water
- package of yeast
- ¹/₄ cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt 2¼ cups flour
- 1 egg
- ¹/₄ cup soft butter

Dissolve yeast in water Add sugar, salt and half of the flour Beat well Add egg, shortening and remaining flour Let rise Shape and use again Line 9" square pan with mixture of butter and brown sugar (about 2tablespoons butter and 1/4 cup brown sugar) Divide batter and 10ll out as for jelly roll, spread with soft butter and sugar and cinnamon Roll and cut Put into pan and let rise Bake at 425 degrees for about 20 minutes

MERINGUE SHELLS WITH STRAWBERRIES egg whites

- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon cream of tarter
- 1½ cup sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla


Beat egg whites, add salt and cream of tartar Add sugar gradlly and vanilla Beat until dry. This is the secret of good meringues. Put 2 tablespoons on brown paper on cookie sheet and shape into a nest Bake in 250 degree oven 1 hour. May be made a day or more in advance and kept in air-tight containers in refrigerator or freezei These must be kept free of dampness. Fill with fresh strawbeiries or strawberiies and ice cream This makes a pretty and very delic-10us dessert
