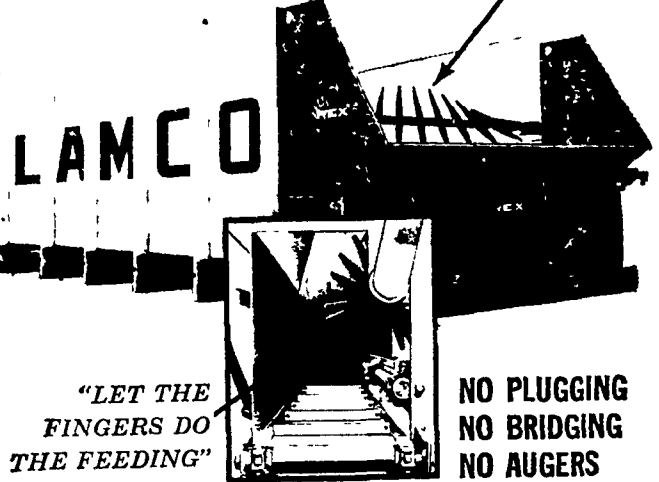

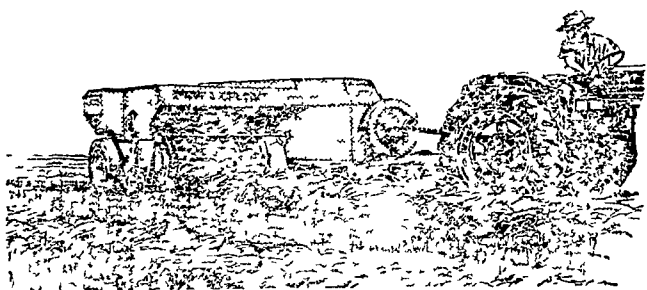

search and nutrition research. A resolution adopted by the NDC Board of Directors meeting in Chicago recently states "funds allocated to NDC will be directed (through DRINC) to nutrition research, and NDC will provide direction and administrative services to insure that the funds are used with maximum effectiveness."

Leadership of both organizations also stressed that this action will have no bearing upon NDC's regular dues income from all segments of the dairy industry.

The NDC Board of Directors acted on the matter of funding additional nutrition research by adopting the resolution recommended by the Special ADA-NDC Study Committee created last year by the ADA and NDC Boards of Directors. The Committee, composed of representatives from all segments of the dairy industry, is chaired by John Moser, president, Kyana Milk Producers, Inc., Louisville, a members of both the ADA and NDC Boards of Directors.

In other action, the NDC Board of Directors authorized its Chairman, James R. Donnan, Secretary, Dairyman's League Cooperative Association, New York, to appoint a committee of dairy processors and equipment and supply manufacturers to raise additional funds for nutrition research from their segments of the industry. Accepting chairman Donnan's appointment to the committee were:

John R. Edwards, president, Sealtest Foods, chairman, Samuel H. Desch, president, Borden Dairy & Services Division, S. C. Sherwood, chairman and executive officer, Fairmont Foods Company, and George L. Huffman, vice president, Ex Cell-O Corporation. It was indicated that the committee could be expanded at some future time.
