In 1968 Hubler served with the Dauphin County Soil and Water Conservation Service and now will further his experience in all phases of conservation work with the local unit.

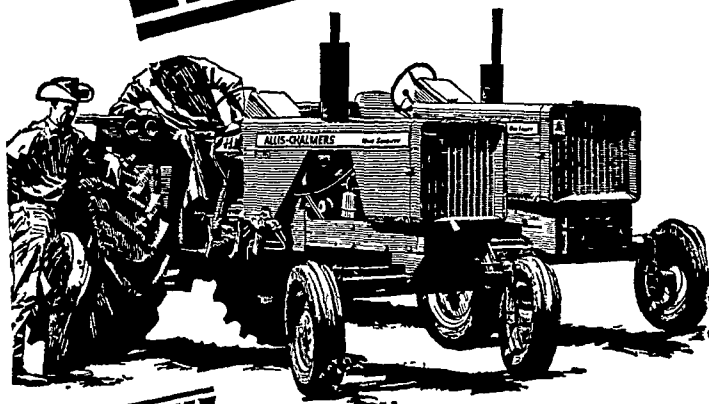

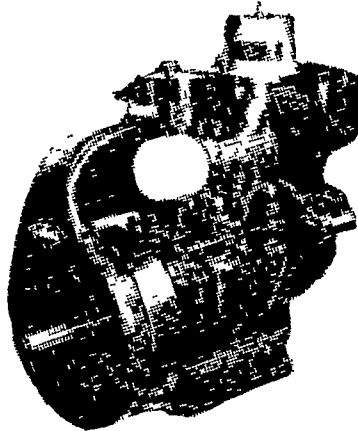
