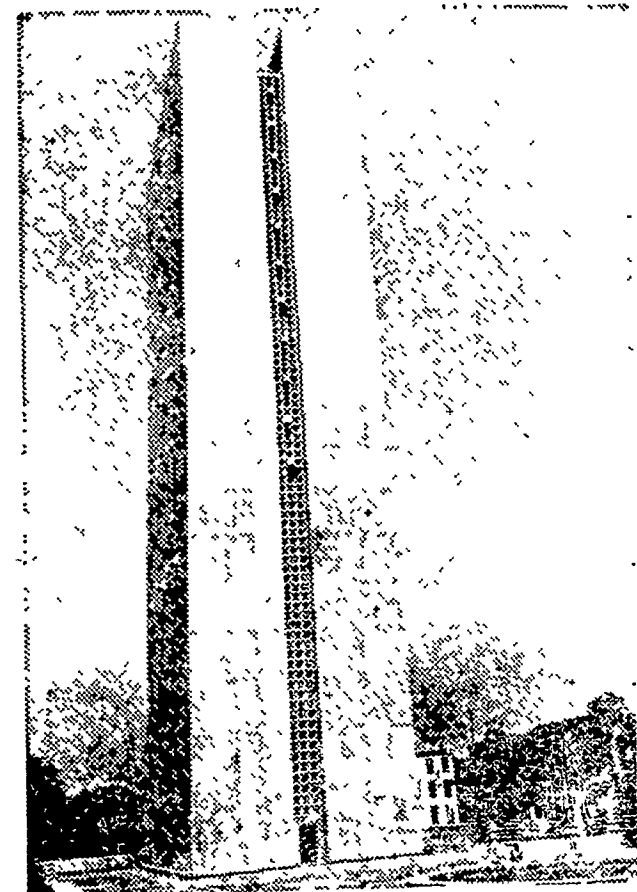

Harrisburg is to Pennsylvania as Washington is to the United States; each has the tone and pace of a small American town.

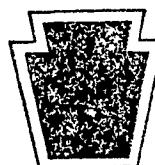
And yet, behind the cement, brick and glass of the buildings, underneath the polite cacaphony of sound—typewriters, high-heeled shoes, mimeograph machines, quiet conversations in elevators, and gracious hellos and nice to see you's, echoing off the walls of long corridors—Harrisburg exists as a dynamic forum for state government. For many years, the city has drawn the top men and women of 67 counties to consider, develop, and guide the destiny of Pennsylvania.

Diversity is the only constant factor of Harrisburg.
