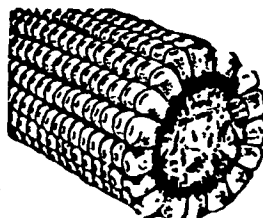

able to Lancaster County Poultrymen, the cases of the New Bolton and Doylestown labs have been considered. The services we have received from these labs has been generally unsatisfactory. The appropriations for these labs are quite sizeable. Could these appropriations be transferred to Harrisburg to provide new equipment and personnel to provide more complete service?

"We hope your studies will provide satisfactory answers for the future planning of state services"

The County poultrymen had been strongly advocating a laboratory to be built on local ground but Hess said a new bridge in the area of the Harrisburg laboratory had made that facility much more accessible.

A statement from New Bolton Laboratory was also shown in which management there listed the services available and urged Lancaster County Poultrymen to use the facilities. Feeling among the directors was that this statement was a rebuttal to the local association's press for better service.

In other business, a two-day tour and a one-day tour to the NEPPCO Exposition in Atlantic City during the week of October 14 was approved. The show had previously been held at Harrisburg but was moved to the Ocean Resort for the first time this year. The tours are planned to go by bus on Wednesday, October 15 with the two day tour staying over at the show on Thursday. Full details of cost and reservation procedures will be reported in Lancaster Farming in a near future issue.

Also local people were asked to help at the Pennsylvania Dutch Days, being held in Hershey August 19-24. Saturday is Lancaster County's day to help at the Poultry Federation's Chicken Barbecue Dinner. Anyone who would like to help is asked to notify a local director.
