A few words with your Agway man about Agway's Complete Crop Program for fall grain is all it'll take.

The program starts with two things. The right seed. The right amount of plant nutrients, properly placed.

The certification tag specifies that Agway Seed has been inspected for physical quality and is free from noxious weeds. Also that the seed is genetically pure. This means that you can be sure of the variety — bag contents conform to the tag.

To get the greatest yield from this high-quality seed, Agway recommends plowing down high phosphate-potash fertilizer, plus use of a starter in the grain drill. Put the majority of the plant nutrients down in the soil where they will be available to the roots of the perennial seedlings.
