Slaughter declined due to difficulty of moving birds off farms in heavy rain, in plant labor shortages and decline in demand. Live supplies ample.

Eastern Pennsylvania And New Jersey

Prices of light type hens about steady. Demand continues good with bidding mixed ranging strong to weaker in instances as some processing plants find it less difficult to obtain needs to maintain near capacity operations. Offerings increased in most quarters with more urgency to move birds off farms in instances. Demand continues to exceed limited offerings of heavy type hens. Prices paid at farm: Light Type Hens: 8-11 M 10½-11c in Pennsylvania M 9½-10c in New Jersey Heavy Type Hens: 1 few.

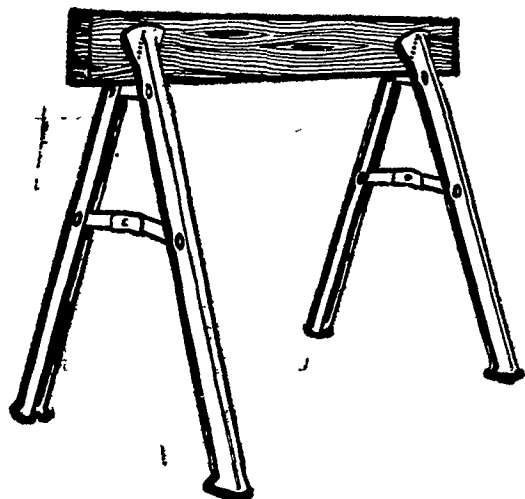

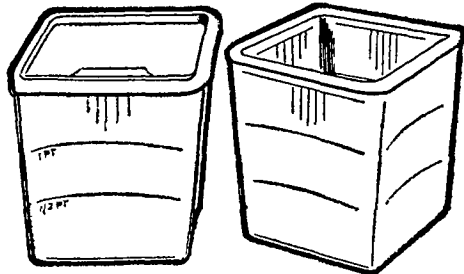
