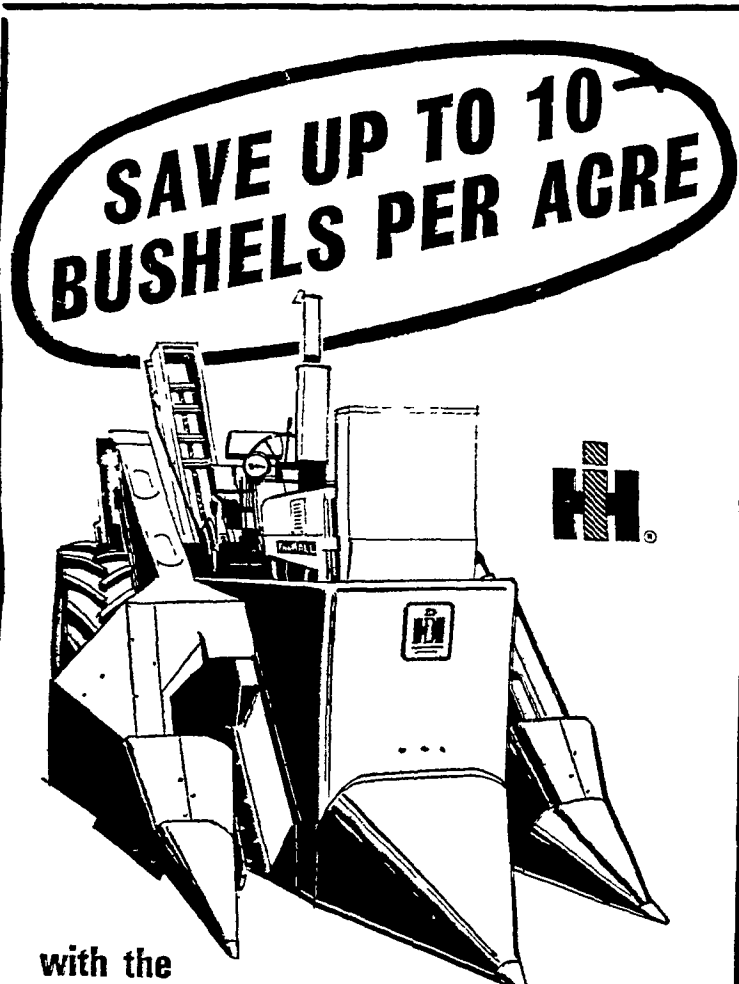

bu per acre barley 56, rape 41 and rye 40. And they get 20 tons per acre from sugar beets.

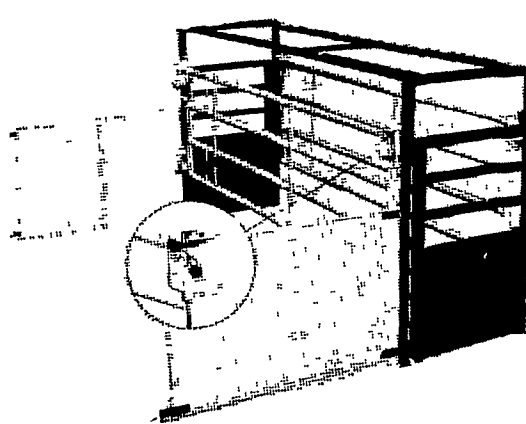
More than 100 persons attended the field day held on the Clarence Harnish Farm located just south of Lampeter. In the morning judging contest, winners were named as follows:
