Turner Reports Milk Sales Up

"July milk sales are recorded as a milestone in the history of milk promotion in Federal Order #2, said Robert S. Turner, Horseheads, President of American Dairy Association and Dairy Council of New York, Inc

In quoting the Market Administrator's report, he said. "Sales of fluid milk products (Class I) increased 10,331,722 pounds or 2.4% over July, 1968. This is the first month where a comparison could be made on milk sales that have been recorded using the same accounting procedure this year as last

"For the past year we have quoted sales increases as compared to the same month the preceding year, but because of the new method used in reporting sales, it was hard to determine what was actually an increase from the sale of milk or what was an increase from the accounting procedure

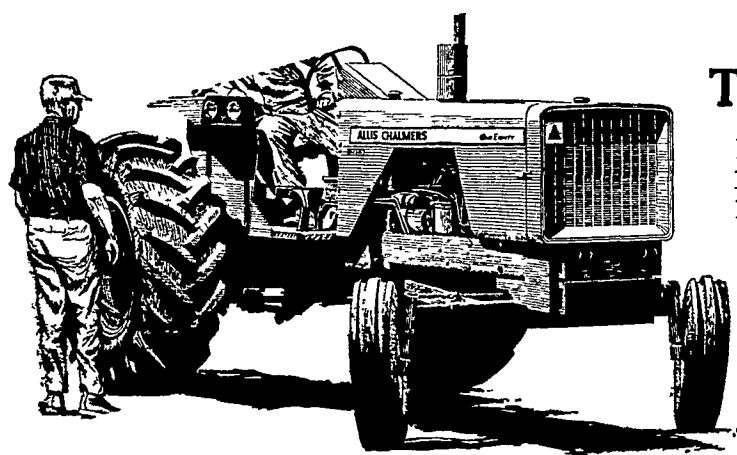

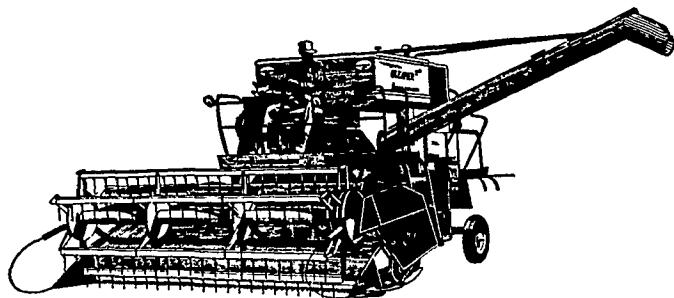

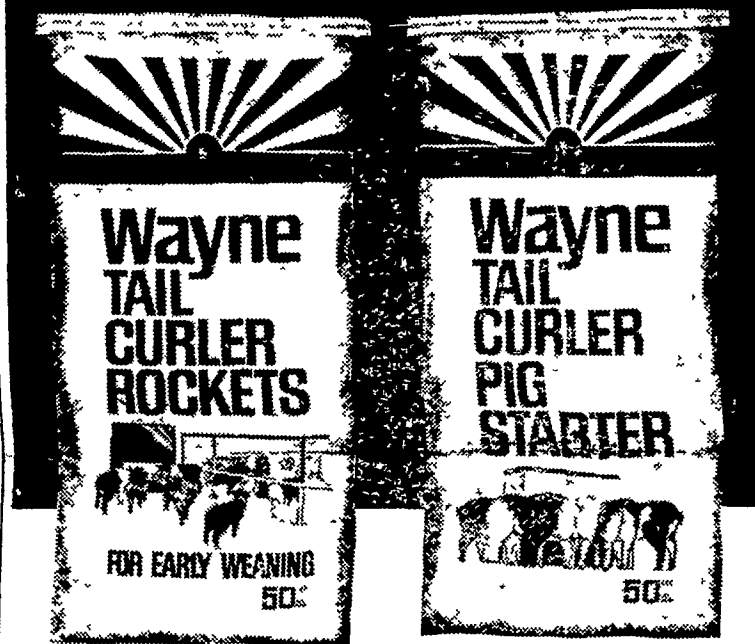
