The Youth committee held a swim party and doggie and corn

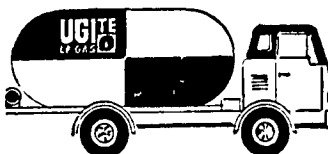

Seeding Lawn

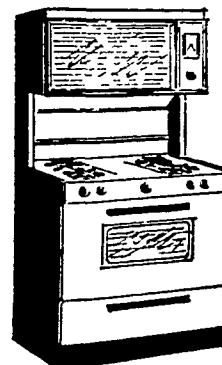
We repeat the recommendation that late August to early September is one of the very best times of the year to seed a new lawn or a new pasture. The cooler weather of the fall months with more constant moisture supplies are favorable to rapid growth of the grasses and good root development. Early fall seedings have a much better chance of surviving the hot, dry weather of next summer than seedings made next spring. A complete soil test will give the amount of lime and fertilizer that should be worked into the topsoil before the grass seeding is made.

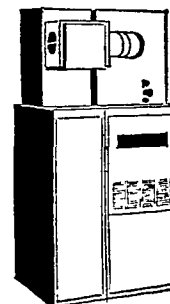

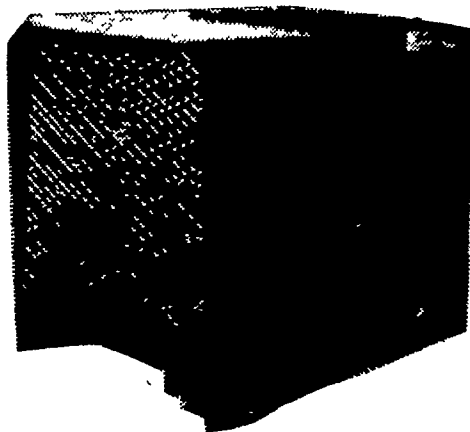
