Ideal weather existed for field work in the county this week.

The Lancaster tobacco harvest is about one-half completed. The crop is earlier than usual and reported to be the best farmers have had in years. Per acre yields may be a ton.

Fall plowing got underway. Hay baling continued during excellent drying weather. Fruit growers enjoyed the good weather for ripening of fruit and apple and peach harvest continues to gain momentum.

Despite the limited shower activity and the excellent drying conditions last week, soil moisture finished out the week with adequate supplies. Because of the good soil moisture situation, pastures are in very good condition for this time of year and are still furnishing average or better amounts of feed.
