days after the August 20 21 disaster, roads were impassible and access was possible only by air. Local representatives of Farmers Home and other agencies were flown in by Civil Defense helicopter to make first contact with people stricken rural communities

A primary function of Department of Agriculture personnel stationed in rural counties is to help direct storm victims to Federal State or other agencies best prepared to offer assistance they need, Smith said. Banking institutions and Federal credit agencies have been in consultation on the mobilization of resources to rebuild homes, farms and businesses.

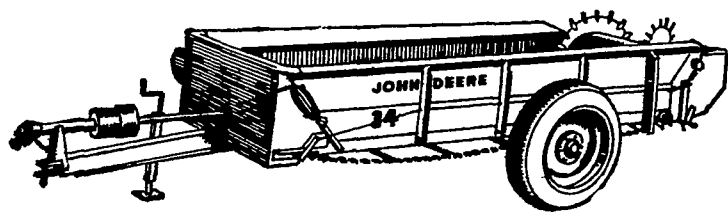

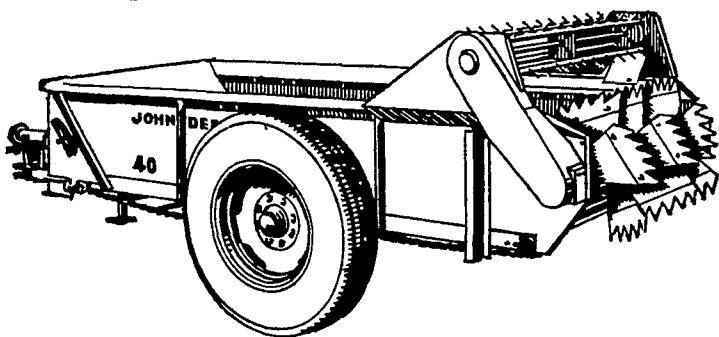
