**87 Bushel Corn Yield Forecast**

Corn yield prospects for the Commonwealth were forecast at 87 bushels per acre on September 1. This was an increase of one bushel from the 86 bushel prediction of the month previous and one bushel below the 1967 record

The Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service said that total corn production is estimated at 78,909,000 bushels and, if realized, will be the second highest of record While the figure is one million bushels short of the huge 1967 crop, expected production would be about 50 percent larger than the 1963 67 average

Hay yields have hit a record high of 2.18 tons per acre, and farmers are now working on later cuttings of both alfalfa and clover Production, expected to reach 4,220,000 tons, is the largest output since 1924 and about 3 percent above last year Both alfalfa and clover yields increased a little from month earlier predictions while other hay yields remained at the same level

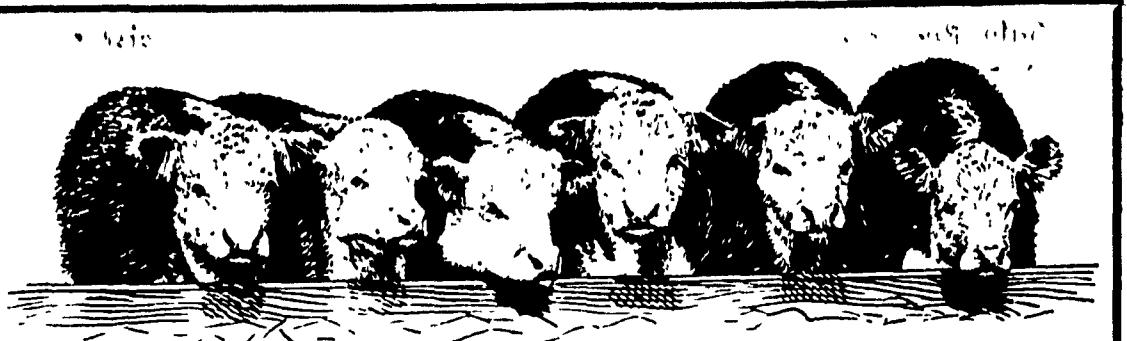
