

New ASC Community Committees Elected

Results of the September 18th election of community ASC Committeemen for the 16 communities in Lancaster County were announced today by Fred G. Seldomridge, Chairman of the Lancaster County ASC Committee. The election was held by mail and ballots were counted publicly by the County ASC Committee on September 18th in the Lancaster County ASC

Office. The ASC Community committee chairman, vice chairman and third regular member automatically become delegates to the county convention where farmers are elected to fill vacancies on the county ASC Committee.

The alternate committeemen become alternate delegates to the convention. The County convention will be held Thursday, September 25th, at 8:00 p.m. in the downstairs meeting room at the Farm and Home Center.

After the County Committee

men are elected the delegates determine which of regular committeemen will serve as committee chairman and vice chairman for the coming year.

Elmer L. Huber, whose term expires this year, will not be eligible for reelection to the county committee, since he has sold his farm. Huber, who has served eleven years on the county committee, was honored at a luncheon by fellow county committeemen and office employees.

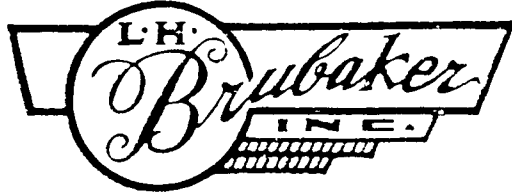

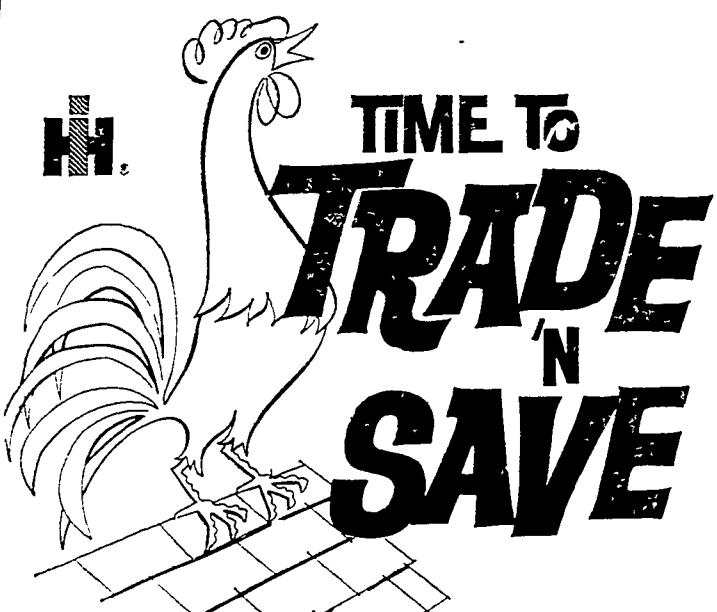

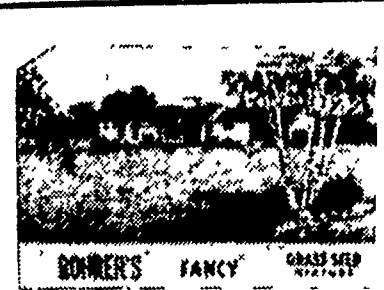
