

County Rabbit Breeders To Hold Fall Show

The Lancaster County Rabbit Breeders Association will be holding its second Fall Rabbit Show on Sunday, October 5th, 1969, in the Willow Street Community Building in Willow Street, Pennsylvania.

The show is open to all persons and any exhibitor may enter rabbits or cavy whether or not he is a member of any rabbit

club or organization. Any persons who are interested in seeing how rabbits are judged are invited to visit the show building between 12:00 NOON and 4:30 P.M. 4-H members are especially welcome to visit or exhibit. Entries close promptly at 11:00 A.M., the day of the show, October 5th. Entry fee is \$1.00 per animal.

The show is sanctioned by the American Rabbit Breeders Association and the Eastern Rabbit and Cavy Breeders Association, and will be governed by their latest official rules. Fourteen breeds of rabbits (Flemish Giants, Dutch, New Zealand, Californians, Satins, English, Champagne D'Argent, Polish, Silver Martens, Checkered Giants, Rex, Tans, Standard Chinchillas, Palominos) have been sweepstaked, and will be judged by judges who are licensed by the American Rabbit Breeders Association. Cavies, commonly called Guinea Pigs, will also be shown and judged. The judging is scheduled to begin at 12:00 Noon and will continue throughout the afternoon. Over 75 trophies plus cash, rabbit pellets, and ribbons for first through fifth place will be awarded as prizes this year.

Refreshments will be available on the premises.

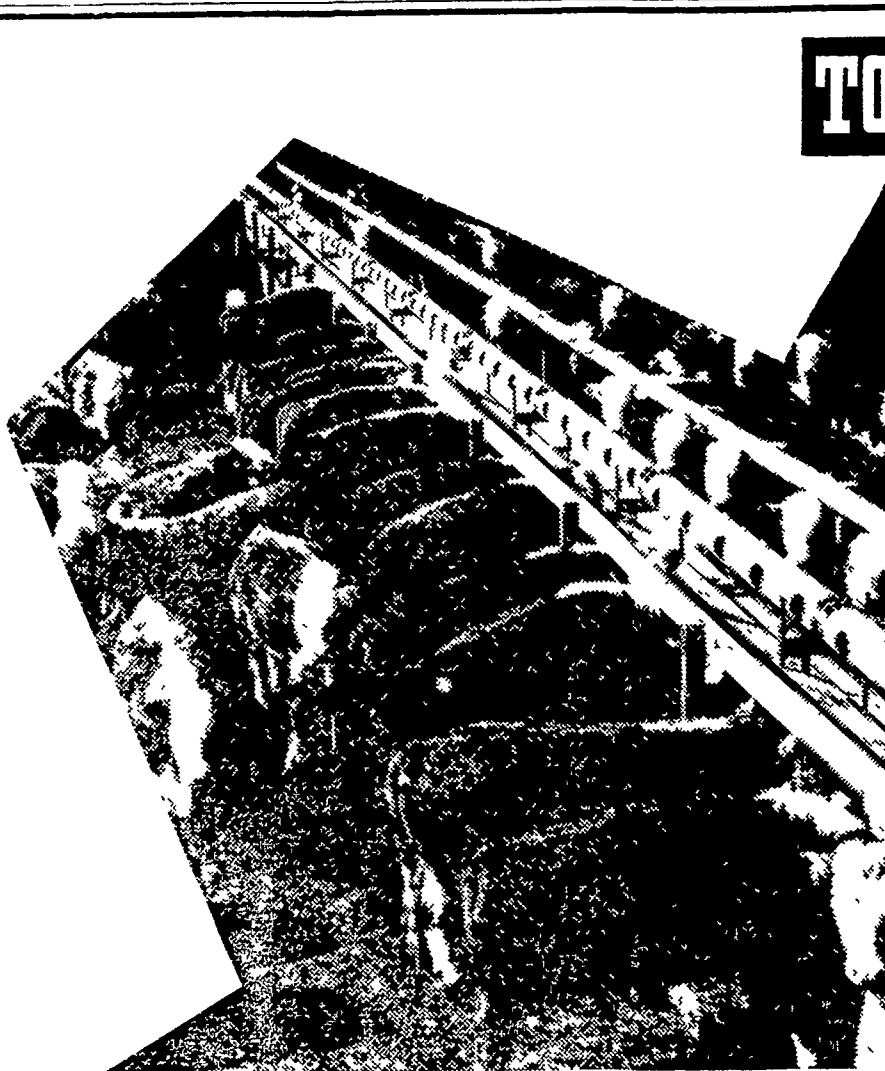
