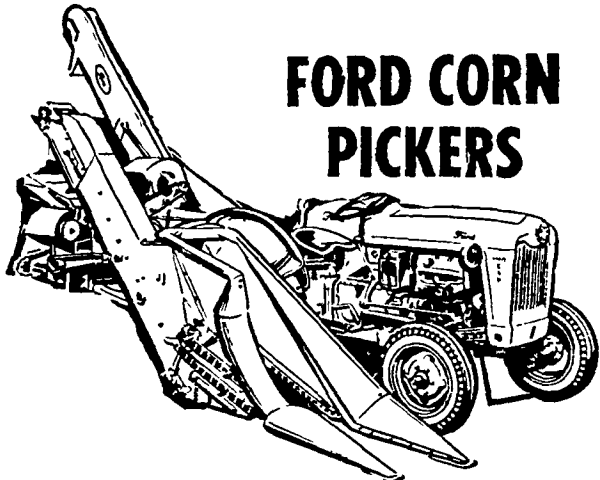

Farm Machinery

Every time I notice another farmer constructing a machinery shed, I recognize what a very good practice this is. In fact, we should have more of these sheds on many farms. Farm machinery is very expensive to buy and to maintain. Good management states that it should be stored out of the weather during the winter

months. As we travel the rural areas of the county, we still see too much machinery stored outside during the winter. This is poor management and is very costly to the owner. Also, the big barns are a temptation to store the machinery in the barn, this is not the best practice and losses run high in case of fire. A separate machin-

ery shed including a repair shop is a very useful building and warrants the attention of more local farmers.

Purchase Quality Plants

One of the best ways to be assured of quality plants materials is to always deal with a local established reputable nurseryman. Reminds J. Robert Nass, extension ornamental horticulturist at The Pennsylvania State University. Check to see if plants are tagged and identifiable with specific variety names. Look for a good choice of sizes, colors and shapes to fill your needs.

Pull Weeds During Fall

It is a good practice to pull those pesky weeds now, remind extension ornamental and vegetable specialists at The Pennsylvania State University. Each weed that goes to seed could mean 5,000 or more weeds next year. By getting rid of them now, you should have a better garden next year.

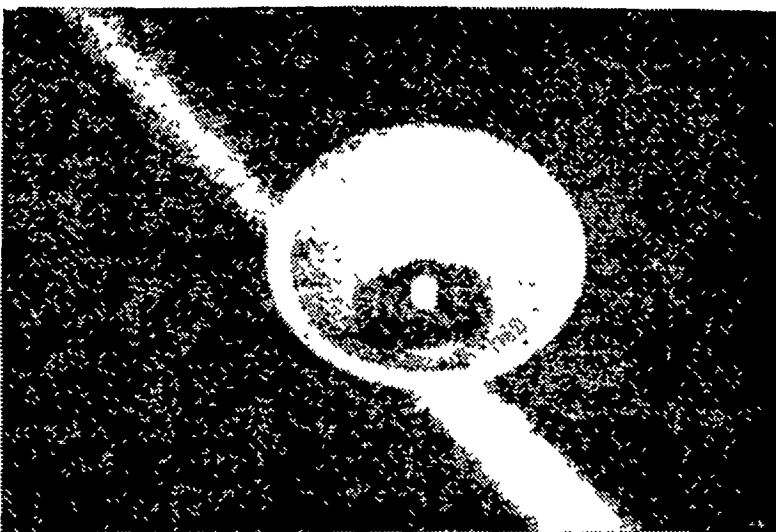

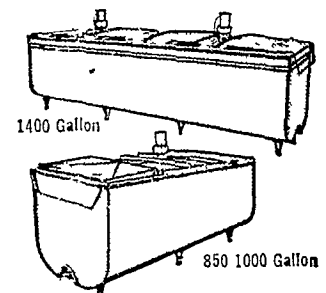
