The right light — this is the the consumer Not the image of eggs in general but the image of your eggs Pennsylvania's or John Doe's eggs This is where advertising and promotion enter the picture What does the consumer think of your eggs?

The right time - timing is very important Is the desired quantity of eggs available when needed? Also are the proper sizes and qualities available? The product must be available when the consumer wants to purchase the eggs, not when someone wants to produce them.

The right price - no matter how efficient a business is in terms of unit costs, if the unit price is below costs and income is less than expenses there is no profit

Marketing often is referred to as a controlling valve indicating the flow of product and infoimation This would include information which should indicate preferences of consumers and the quantity of the product which is needed at the desired price In order for production to supply the marketer with the right product in the right quantity at the right price and at the right time, marketing must channel the information from the consumer back to the producer In tuin, producers need this information to plan quantities of layers and times when pullets must be housed

Much of the emphasis being placed on marketing today is directed toward market orientation lather than product ottentation — producing for a market - not producing to market


Yes, marketing as defined in this article is already being applied by some firms Perhaps more firms will follow this approach in the future
