Butternut Squash

Seasonal supplies, reasonable prices and excellent quality mean butternut squash is on the market.

This deep yellow fleshed squash is rich in vitamin A. A half cup of winter squash will provide almost all the vitamin A you need for one day.

Butternut squash has a tan colored and smooth skin.

It is shaped like a gourd and has a thick neck with a bulb like end.

The squash can range from six inches to more than a foot in length.

Storing Summer Clothes

Discard items that you won't be able to use again.

Remove all stains from summer clothes. Launder washables but don't starch. Starch attracts insects.

If storing clothes in boxes or trunks, fold them smooth and flat in tissue paper to prevent wrinkles. Label each container as to its contents.

Pennsylvania Apples

Games Golden apples are clear, deep yellow with pale russet dots. The skin is a little rough. They are slightly tart, very crisp and excellent for sauce pie eating and raw.

Red Delicious are solid red, occasionally red striped. Cone shaped, five points with crown

at blossom end. They are hard, mild, sweet, moderately juicy and good for eating raw, salads and baking.

Golden Delicious are clear, deep yellow, cone shaped, firm, mildly flavored, moderately juicy and excellent for eating raw, salads or baking.

York Imperials are red striped on yellow. They have a pinkish blush and are lopsided. They have a tart taste and are firm and crisp. They are excellent for baking and pies and fair for eating raw.

Rome Beauties are red striped mingled with yellow. They are greenish around the stem, tart, crisp, moderately juicy and excellent for baking and pies and fair for eating raw.

Stayman apples are dull red with white dots concentrated near blossom end, quite firm, crisp, tart with a yellow flesh. They are excellent for baking and pies and good for eating raw and in salads.

Selecting Pears

Avoid pears with a warty or shiveled look — they have been picked at such an immature state that they won't ever ripen properly.

Avoid pears with a water- (Continued on Page 25)

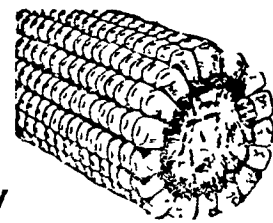

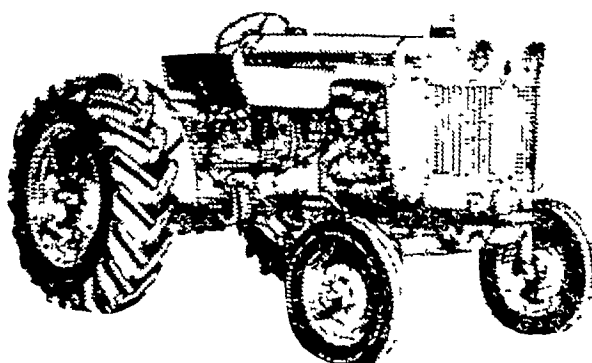
