

in a corner and hidden by another product.”

Mr. Hemstra continued, successful management must be scientific. You must be able to vary the methods stated by “the book” . . . you must have something called insight.

Mr. R. L. Thompson, supervisor of the Maryland Egg Law, Department of Markets, University of Maryland, along with Mr. Charles McCam, told about the Maryland Egg Laws, and their enforcement, present and future. They also told the merchandisers that many services are available from the Department of Markets at the University of Maryland and that all the “eggmen” have to do is ask.

Everett Stiles, another speaker at the clinic and Vice President of the P & O Stores, Syracuse, New York, told the members of the Maryland State Poultry Council about the very successful way his stores merchandise eggs.

He added that, “eggs at their present price are an awfully good food buy. You can buy two dozen eggs for a pound of steak,” he continued, “and one and a half dozen for a pound of hot dogs.”

Mr. John Mahoney, chief of marketing services and superintendent of weights and measures at the University of Maryland, gave a slide tape presentation on some new ideas for marketing eggs.

The meeting, held at Eudowood Gardens, was sponsored by the Maryland State Poultry Council, Inc, in cooperation with the Department of Markets and the Department of Poultry Science, University of Maryland.
