

## Sportsmen Join To Stop Pollution

Sportsmen and outdoor enthusiasts are urged to join in active participation for stream cleanup during 1970 by the Eastern Sports and Outdoor Show. As part of a continuing involvement in conservation and recreational concern, the show will sponsor a basic and hard-driving program to promote awareness for and participation in the conditions that demand that a stop be brought to stream pollution.

The Eastern Sports and Outdoor Show has become an outdoor recreation focal point and acts as a showcase for a fourteen state area. This area is comprised of Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland, District of Columbia, Virginia, West Virginia, Ohio, New York, and all of New England. Each of these states has a prime recreational resource of streams, rivers and lakes. The major portion of this vast water resource is now polluted; some of it is beyond reclamation.

The 1970 Eastern Sports and Outdoor Show theme will set the mood and pace to develop a high level of concern for the present and future of stream protection and conservation. The many thousands of sportsmen and outdoor people who attend the show during the week of February 9-14 will join to help launch this drive in the name of conservation and pollution control.

The Eastern Sports and Outdoor Show has always made an active effort to advance conservation and multiple land use pro-

grams. John Altland, president of the Eastern Sports and Outdoor Show organization, said "This year we are singling out stream pollution as a theme and for complete show involvement. Our consideration for this project is not because it's worthy, but because it is a necessity. Time is running out for outdoor America. The Eastern Sports and Outdoor Show will commit its entire facilities for a solid grassroots approach to bring awareness into action. All citizens will be invited to participate and the Eastern Sports and Outdoor Show will continue to form suggestions and guidelines for the use of outdoor clubs and sportsmen's organizations."

tein available to your livestock and reduced milk production.

Weeds also affect the palatability of the hay. Some varieties — cheatgrass, for example — can cause mouth and throat ailments in livestock. What's more, weedy hay can result in off-flavor, unmarketable milk.

Add weed control to your overall crop management and these problems can be avoided, crop specialists recommend. As

## FREY FREE STALL

Lifetime Free Stall Housing



Cut bedding costs 75%, reduce labor for barn cleaning and cow washing; reduce teat and udder injury to the minimum — house your milking herd in free stall housing. Each cow provided a stall for loafing. She won't be stepped on, the rear curb forces manure out into alley for mechanical cleaning or washing. A few minutes twice a day cleans the stalls and curbs, bedding lasts almost forever if your stalls fit the cows. Popular sizes are 6'6", 7' and 7'6". Size 'em by breed.

Our free stall partition may be mounted on wooden head boards or we make a steel divider. Set the legs in 8 to 10" concrete curbs to hold and retain bedding. Stall floor can be soil, sand or gravel. Bedding — straw, sawdust, peanut hulls, ground corn cobs, etc. Should be installed with paved alley surface 8 feet wide for mechanical cleaning or washing.

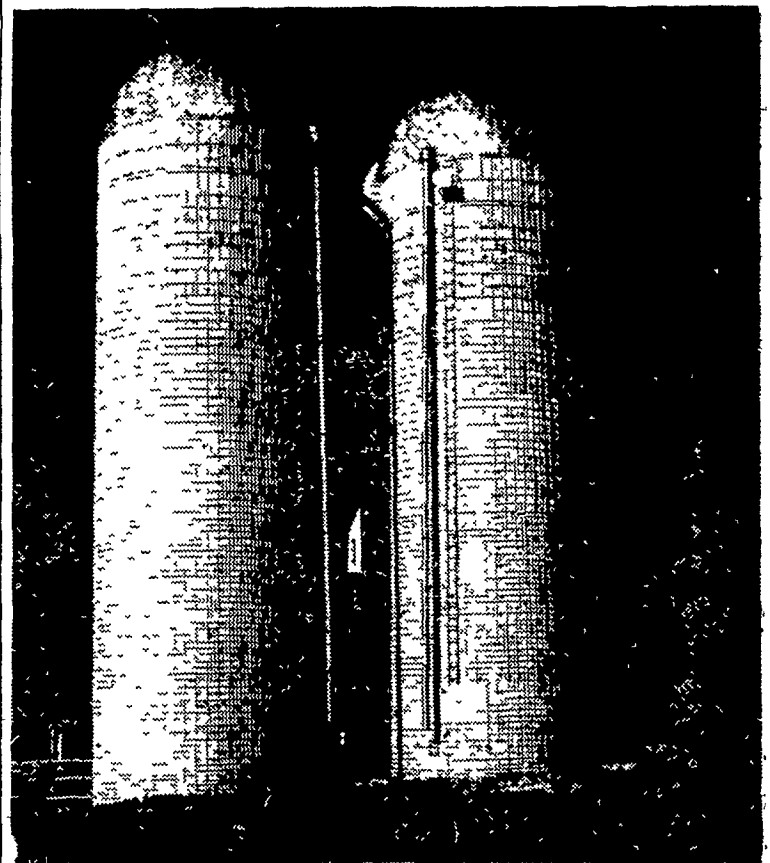

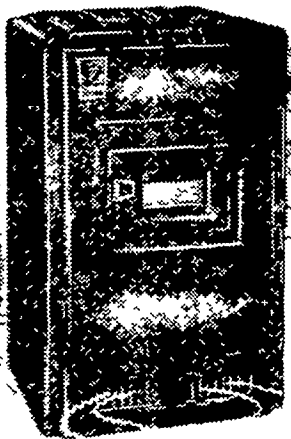
