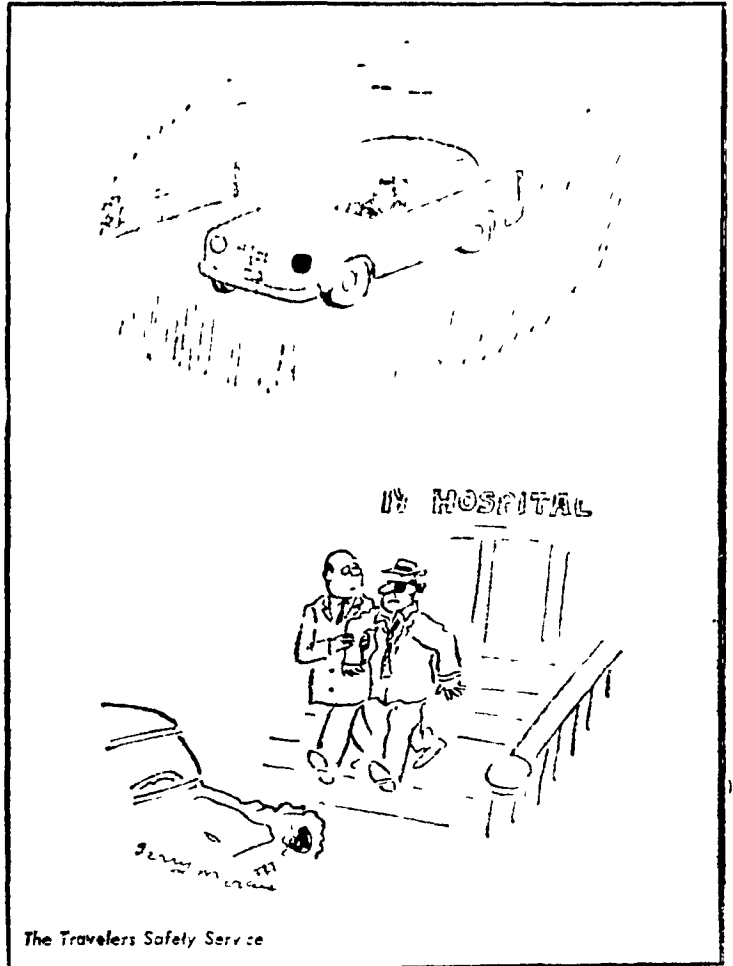

Uruguay ranks as the world's leader in meat consumption with a per capita average of 227 pounds, the Penn State department head pointed out The United States ranks fifth with an average of 178 pounds consumed per person

### Muskrat Trapping Season Opens Nov. 22

The 1969 trapping season for mink and muskrat will open at 7 a.m on Saturday, November 22, and continue through noon on Sunday, January 11

Minks and muskrats, as well as other furbearers, are in fairly good supply this year

Last year, prices paid for skins were considerably higher than they had been for many years but the current price outlook is still uncertain Prices on most furs have not yet been stabilized

During October there was little movement of last year's furs from shippers and merchants to brokers and manufacturers The volume of unsold furs of all kinds is believed sufficient to satisfy immediate demand

This may force the "opening market prices for the new crop of furs somewhat lower than the closing prices of last winter and

spring However, an improvement in the market is expected as the season progresses

The Game Commission advises that trappers might gain by

pelting their hides during the early part of the season holding them until the market has improved

Beaver season in Pennsylvania will open February 7 and end on March 8, 1970 Trappers will also be permitted to take muskrats again at that time

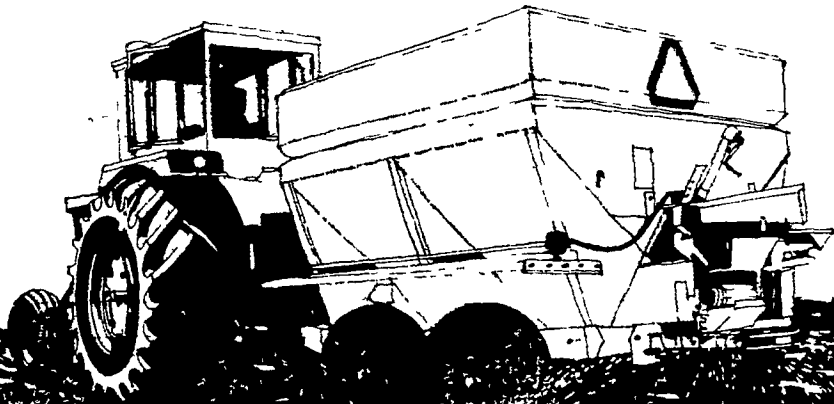
