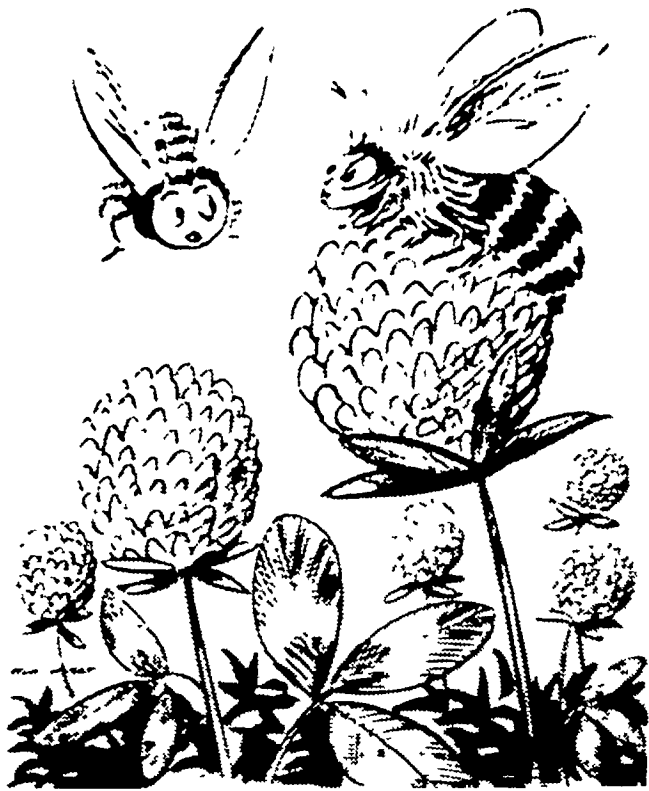

## Snowmobiles Illegal On State Game Lands

Hunters are reminded that it is illegal to drive snowmobiles on State Game Lands, other than Game Commission roads open to public travel, during the upcoming bear and deer seasons. It is unlawful at any time to drive snowmobiles on township or state roads traversing Game Lands, under provisions of the Vehicle Code.

With interest in snowmobiles mushrooming and sales soaring, some outdoorsmen may have entertained the thought that this would be a means of crossing State Game Lands in big game seasons.

They are advised that to do so is unlawful.

### The Pennsylvania Department

of Agriculture has lodged a protest with the Interstate Commerce Commission over a proposed 6 percent increase in rail freight rates. The Commission is scheduled to hear oral arguments November 12 on the rate increase requested by the nation's railroads.

State Agriculture Secretary Leland H. Bull, in a telegram to the ICC, protested proposed increases "particularly as applied to grain, grain products, feed, and feed ingredients."

He pointed out that a general percentage increase continues to place an inequitable burden on Northeastern farm producers, and that rates available to similar producers in the Southeastern states are generally lower.

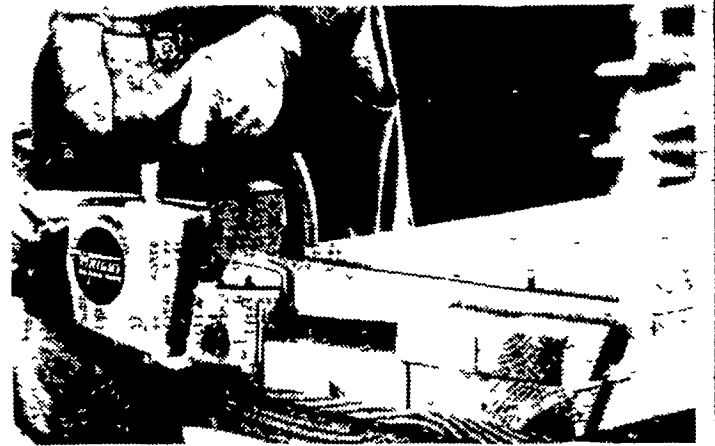

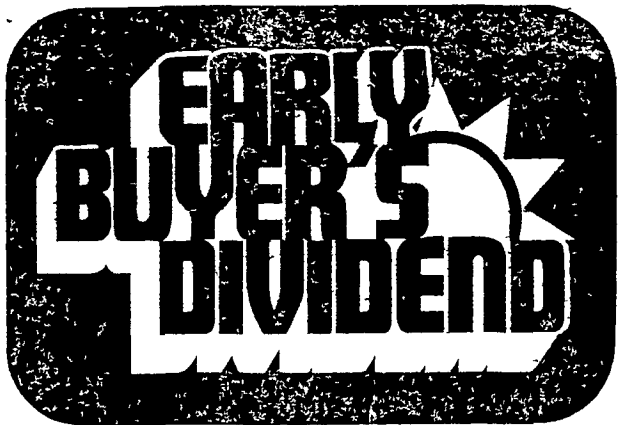

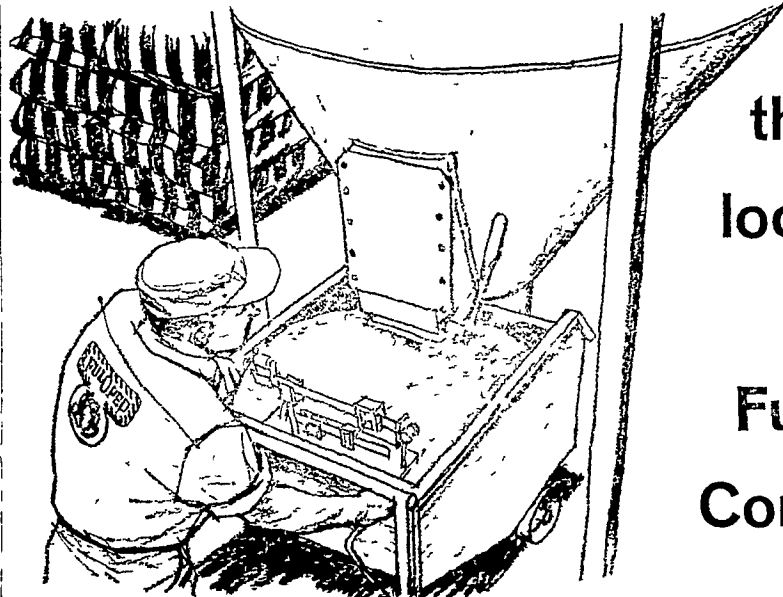
