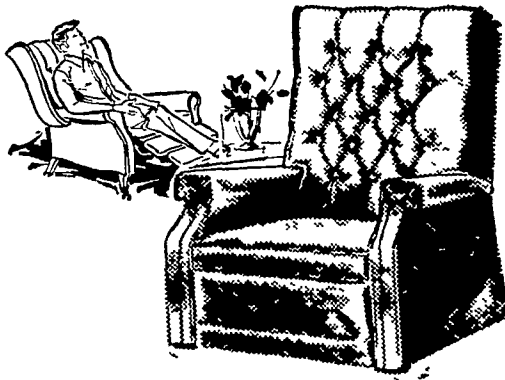

### How To Buy Cauliflower

Look for white to creamy white, compact solid, and clean florettes.

A slightly granular or "ricey" curd texture will not hurt the eating quality if the surface is compact.

If jacket leaves are attached make sure they have a good green color — a sign of freshness

Avoid cauliflower that has a spreading of the curd. Smudgy or speckled appearance of the curd can be a sign of deterioration from insect injury, mold, or decay and should be avoided.

### Keep Your Keys Safe

More than 45 million keys are lost annually. House keys labeled with your name and address are perfect invitations to the finder if he happens to be of the burglar or prowler type.

Keys dangling on a ring, such as house keys on your car ignition ring, can be removed, duplicated and returned to your car quickly.

Remember to remove all other keys from the car ignition ring when you have your car serviced or parked by an attendant.

A separate key ring for office, house, and/or your car is well worth the trouble. You might find a snap-apart key chain convenient.
