

Treatment consists of removing the foleign body from the puncture wound, either by surgery or by the use of magnets, and in controlling the infection with antibiotics and sulfas, the University of Maryland veterinarian continues

Prevention is always the best and can be done by keeping all foreign material out of the cow's feed.


A further and in prevention is to place a magnet in the reticulum of each cow This should be done before the first pasture season, but may be done anytime after she is 10-12 months of age.
