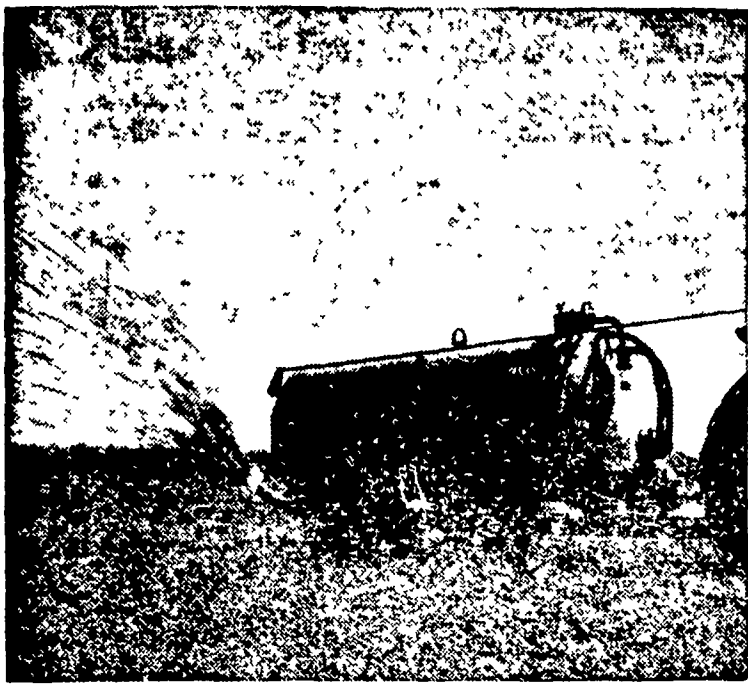


Farm Machinery make every effort to get his equipment under roof. Machinery that is out in the weather will rust and then break down when put to hard use; also, rust

shortens the life of any piece of equipment. A special shed or machinery barn is strongly recommended. If this is not possible, then storage in the barn or tobacco shed will give protection. The problem with barn storage is that in case of fire, the losses will be more severe. Good management states that farm machinery should be stored in a dry place when not in use, and all working parts greased for the Winter.

Pennsylvania Broiler Placements Up 4%
Placements of broiler chicks in the Commonwealth during the week ending November 29 were 985,000. The placements were 4% above the same week a year earlier but 14% below the previous week. Average placements during the past 10 weeks were 15% above a year earlier. Settings for broiler chicks were 1,794,000 — 7% below the previous week but 17% above the comparable period a year earlier. The current 3-week total of eggs set is 22% above the same period a year ago. In shipments of broiler-type chicks during the past 10 weeks averaged 8,000 and compares with 12,000 a year ago. Outshipments average 304,000 during the past 10 weeks, 19% above a year earlier.
22 STATES Placements in the 22 States were 55,023,000 — 3% below the previous week and 13% above the same week a year earlier. Average placements during the past 10 weeks were 12% above a year ago. Settings were 71,521,000 — slightly below the previous week but 14% above a year earlier. The current 3-week total of eggs set is 13% above the comparable period a year ago

Cattle Lice
Controlling cattle lice now prevents them from building up during the Winter months. In a recent research study done in Arizona on two year-old Hereford heifers, it was found that the group heavily infested with body lice lost 80 pounds per head more during the Winter than those free of body lice. The recommendation states that it is definitely economically advantageous for livestock owners to eliminate lice from all of their cattle. In our local feed lots many farmers have the problem of cattle lice infestation and should not be tolerated for best returns. Sprays will obtain better control than dusts and should be done on a warm day with the use of cold water and an insecticide such as cyodrin, the treatment should be repeated in two to three weeks.
