

## A View From The Governor's Office

One of the proudest moments of my life came last week when I was able to give six outstanding Young Pennsylvanians a voice in making State Government policy affecting their lives.

Six weeks ago, I received a report at our Youth Conference that resulted from discussions and work of more than 24,000 young Pennsylvanians

One of its major recommendations was that young people be appointed to positions in State Government where they will have a significant policy making role.

I agreed with that recommendation because I believe that young people today should be heard and involved in the democratic process more than ever before.

For it is from the youth of America that we hear the greatest criticism of our free institutions. Thus, it is time that they have an opportunity to see how it all works; to participate in arriving at decisions; and to seek constructive, not destructive, changes in our society.

With the appointment of these six outstanding young Pennsylvanians to the Department of Public Welfare, who were selected from their demonstrated ability and desire to serve, we are moving from lip service to action

These young Pennsylvanians are being appointed to agencies of State Government that deal with such important community problems as child care, family service and public assistance

Carol Keegan, of Dunmore, and Abraham Tyler, of York, will serve as youth advisors to

the State Board of Public Welfare.

Thomas Gentzel, of State College, will serve on the Board of the Central Pennsylvania Youth Development Centers.

David Fontaine, of Wilkes-Barre, will serve the Board of the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Development Centers.

Randy Roebuck, of Carlisle, is being appointed to the Advisory Committee on Public Assistance and,

Gregory King, of Coatesville, to the Advisory Committee on Children and Youth.

These young people, in whom I personally have the deepest

faith and trust, are making history — history for Pennsylvania and the Nation.

For in no other state of our Nation has a program to involve youth in the operation of free institutions been undertaken on such a scale.

In ceremonies announcing their selection, I told them: "You are the first of many young people who will be appointed to policy positions in our Commonwealth agencies.

"I expect you to discharge your new responsibility with a sense of dedication that only young minds can bring to an issue. You seek change. We are giving you the opportunity to bring change about in a constructive way.


"You are now in a position to speak loud and clear for the young people of our Commonwealth.

major step by your generation. It is a way to bring reason to and mine to speak and listen to our dialogue.



## CHOP FODDER INTO CLEAN LIVESTOCK BEDDING




