Fred A. Hughes Receives State Dairymen's Award

HARRISBURG — Frederick A. Hughes, professor of farm management Extension at the Pennsylvania State University, Monday night was named winner of the 1969 Pennsylvania Dairymen's Association Award of \$100 and an inscribed plaque at the 54th Farm Show.

The award, "for valuable and noteworthy contributions to the Commonwealth's dairy industry," was presented to Hughes at the state dairy association's annual meeting.

Established in 1962, the awards program is designed to give recognition to a member of the Penn State Extension Service for aid to the state's largest agricultural enterprise.

A native of Ebensburg, Hughes earned two degrees from Penn State — a bachelor of science in agricultural education and master of science in agricultural economics.

Prior to being named to the Extension staff in 1954, he was an agricultural economist at Ohio State University for three years. He also managed a dairy farm in Chester County.

Hughes was responsible for the field testing and final establishment of the Penn State Farm Records Program, which uses data processing as a tool to offer a complete accounting system to all farmers of Pennsylvania.

He served as chairman of the successful Penn State Unit Demonstration Farm Program and summarized the financial results

and the forerunner of many that exist today as far away as Miami, Florida.

of the 120 farms in the project. The records summarized from these farms became valuable teaching aids for all Extension farm management programs.

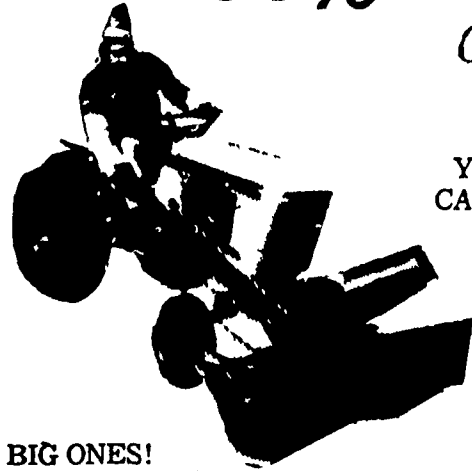
Hughes is a popular speaker at county dairy days, presenting topics on how to use the modern techniques of record summaries and analysis to manage farms at a profit.

He is author of numerous publications on farm management and agricultural economics which stresses the importance of accurate farm business records.

Hughes is a member of the American Farm Economics Association, Northeast Farm Managers and Rural Appraisers Association, Pennsylvania Grassland Council, and Pennsylvania plant Food Educational Society.

He is a founder and past president of the Extension Professors Association, a member of Alpha Tau Alpha and Delta Theta Sigma, agricultural fraternities, and Epsilon Sigma Phi, national Extension honorary fraternity.

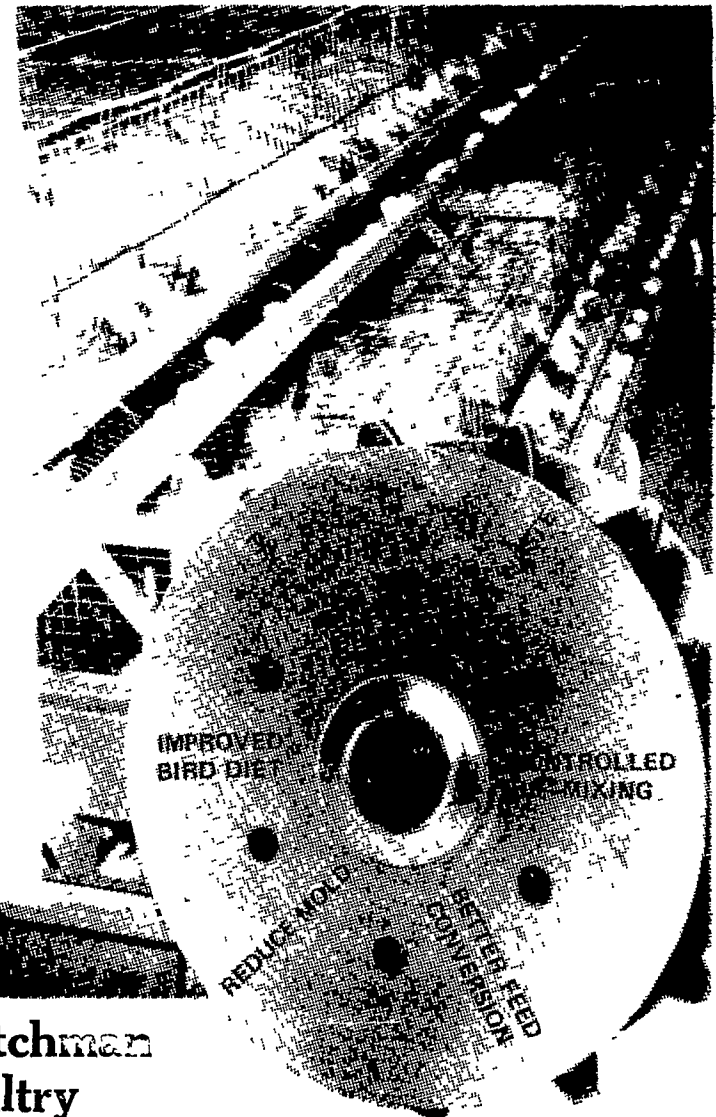

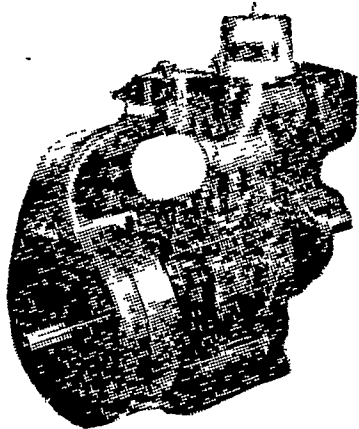
