When You Buy Gloves

Choose those that are becoming to your hands. See if the glove is well proportioned for the length, width, and shape of your hand and fingers. A glove should fit your hand comfortably.

Check if seams are well-placed and sewn with matching or harmonizing thread.

Fasteners need to be evenly spaced and neatly sewed.

Gloves are made of natural or man-made fibers, plastic or leather. Each material is best suited for certain types of gloves and their intended use. Choose the type that best meets your needs.

Prices vary according to quality and finish of materials and to the design and construction of the gloves.

To get full value for the money you spend on gloves, read the label for specific recommendations on use and care.

Truth In Lending

Where the Truth in Lending Law applies, the dealer or lender must present in writing to you, before credit is given the following information:

The total amount charged for credit except for credit in buying a house.

The date the finance charge begins.

The annual percentage rate. The number, amount, and due dates of payments.

The amount and method used to figure the charge for late payments or failure to pay.

Description of any security held.

Penalty charged for prepayment of principal.

Adjustments made in the credit charge when payments are made in advance.

Keep Your Keys Safe

More than 45 million keys are

lost annually. House keys labeled with your name and address are perfect invitations to the finder if he happens to be of the burglar or prowler type.

Keys dangling on a ring, such as house keys on your car ignition ring, can be removed, duplicated and returned to your car quickly.
