Fire At Vintage Sales

Fire at the Vintage Sales Stables on Route 30 east, about 7 30 a m Wednesday destroyed 10 tons of hay but caused little damage to buildings

Some of the nearly 700 head of livestock at the stables were penned near the blaze but were quickly heided away from the smoke There was no loss of animals

Harold A Hess, secretary-treasurer of the stables said damage to the buildings appeared minimal and credited the quick response of firemen with containing the blaze

Hess said operations at the stables were continuing as usual with the exception that all cattle were being loaded from the east end of the stables instead of the west

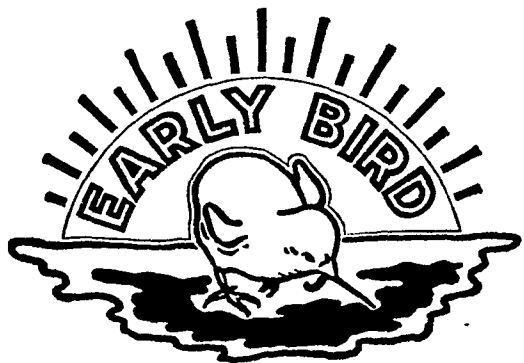
