### Snowmobile Popularity Studied In 7 Counties

Farm and forest lands are undergoing new demands for space to use the increasingly popular snowmobile, according to faculty

members in the School of Forest Resources at The Pennsylvania State University.

Stanley B. Johnson and Ronald A. Bartoo describe snowmobil-

ing as the newest or many activities comprising the nation's \$20 billion per year outdoor recreation. To analyze use of snowmobiles, Johnson and Bartoo headed up a study in seven counties of Central Pennsylvania during the 1967-68 season.

The survey showed that snowmobiles are mainly operated on private or state lands within or adjoining the county of the owner's residence. Private landowners will generally grant permission for snowmobile use, but stipulate restrictions. Interviewed were snowmobile owners, dealers, and private landowners in Blair, Cambria, Centre, Clearfield, Clinton, Huntingdon, and Mifflin counties.

The snowmobile owner is generally male, married, middle-aged, and above the national average in education and income. He lives in an urban environment and holds a job requiring special skills. Snowmobiles are used chiefly for family recreation.

The average family used their snowmobile 30 days during the 1967-68 season, with weekend use predominant. Ownership satisfaction was considered good to excellent by 89 per cent of the persons interviewed. Ninety-six per cent of the people in the sample said they would buy a snowmobile again if they had the opportunity. They appear to derive much enjoyment from their machine.

Johnson and Bartoo point out that government agencies are anxious to know more concerning the questions of "how much," "who," and "when," to better determine what regulations are needed for snowmobile use. There are now about 48 companies manufacturing snowmobiles. Sales increased from a mere 2,000 units in 1959 to estimated sales of between 200,000 to 250,000 machines during the 1968 to 1969 seasons.

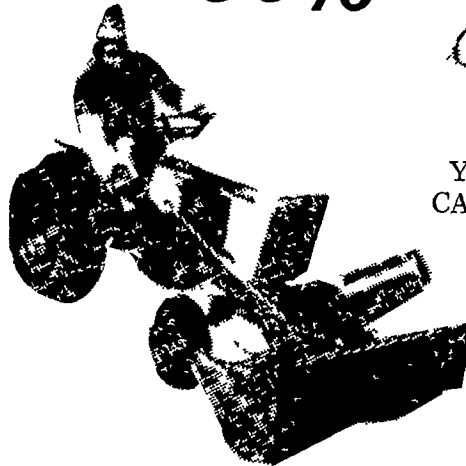

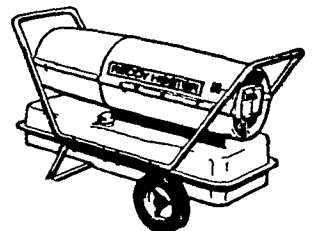
