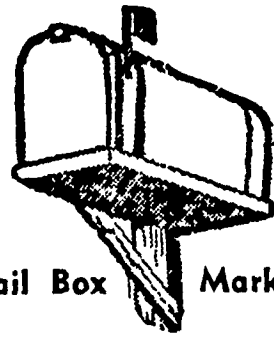
Presbyterian Church on Saturday, March 14 at 1 p.m.

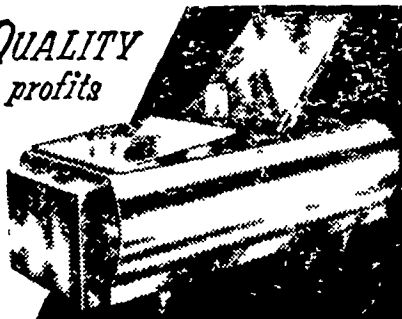

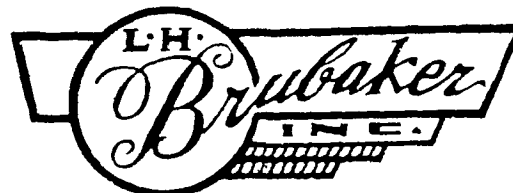
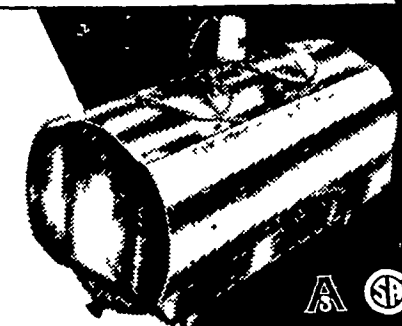
