Maximum Yields —
Grow 30 ton silage per acre and go for 40 ton per acre.

★ FEEDING

1. CHALLENGE FEEDING

10% shortage in energy can reduce income \$100. per cow per year.

2. FORAGE TESTING

Feeding a 16% Protein feed when a 20% level is needed can result in a 3 lb. per day loss in milk production and increased feed costs.

3. FREE CHOICE SALT & MINERALS

Improper calcium and phosphorus balance can affect herd health and lower production.

★ HERD MANAGEMENT

1. Grow heifers to freshen at 24 months
2. Clean Milk Program — Mastitis causes costly losses
3. Cull low producers and cows open more than 100 days
4. Profile Farm Record System

★ MATERIALS HANDLING

Plan housing, feeding and milking systems that will enable the sale of "a ton of milk per man per day".
