Elverson Farmer's Holstein Tops 32,000 Pounds of Milk

The Holstein-Friesian Association of America has announced several awards to outstanding area farmers.

A Registered Holstein cow owned by Jefferson D. Yoder, Elverson, has exceeded 30,000 pounds of milk.

Rocky-Side Lena 5753321 (EX-2E) actually produced a total of 32,119 pounds of milk and 1,035 pounds of butterfat in 365 days.

Her record started at the age of six years and one month. On a

two times-per-day milking schedule, she averaged nearly 41 quarts of milk each day throughout her testing period.

The Yoder Holstein's production is more than three times that of the average dairy cow. Lena was sired by Hilltop Apollo Ivanhoe 1399824 (G), a bull that has earned a Gold Medal Sire recognition.

Production sampling, weighing and testing operations were supervised by Pennsylvania State University in cooperation with the national Holstein organization.

butterfat. Brenda's production totaled 23,500 pounds of milk and 1,152 pounds of butterfat in 305 days.

A registered Holstein cow, Penmar Polly Ivanhoe Holly 6086449 (EX), owned by Earl F. Noel, Hanover, claimed the 2,845th yearly production record exceeding half a ton of butterfat in 350 days.

Among seven Pennsylvania breeders qualifying for the Progressive Breeders' Award, the highest recognition attainable by a breeder of Registered Holstein cattle, were:

Warren N. and Karl L. Hertzler, Conewago Farm, Elizabethtown, qualified for the fifth time.

Ferndale Farms, Lebanon, qualified for the fourth time.

Hertzler's Dairy Farm, Elizabethtown, qualified for the third time.
