Richard Breckbill, Oxford RD1 50 cows, 15,533 milk and 601 butterfat.

son, "Stella, Holstein, 365 days, 34,795 milk and 1,431 butterfat, Lieske and son, "Pam," Holstein, 308 days, 25,860 milk, 877 butterfat; Mr. and Mrs. William Myer, "No. 187," Holstein, 365 days, 25,794 milk and 959 butterfat, Mr. and Mrs. Harold Ranck, "Polly," Holstein, 356 days, 25,122 milk and 877 butterfat, Kaufman Brothers, "Vigh", Holstein, 363 days, 23,701 milk and 1,023 butterfat.

Young Brothers, 83, Jersey, 305 days, 13,289 milk and 717 butterfat, Mr. and Mrs. Nelson Young, "Sybil," Ayrshire, 365 days, 14,084 milk and 523 butterfat, and Mr. and Mrs. James Dodds, "Genette," Guernsey, 365 days, 16,596 milk and 791 butterfat.

Holstein, 1,000 pounds of butterfat or 25,000 pounds of milk, Brown Swiss, 800 pounds of butterfat or 25,000 pounds of milk, Ayrshire, Guernsey or Jersey, 750 pounds of butterfat or 14,000 pounds of milk.

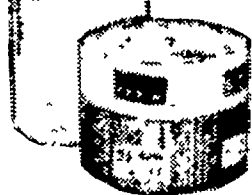
