Anyone can enroll. The complete course comes in a single mailing. You may take the exams or not, whichever you like. After you get the course it's yours to do with as you wish.

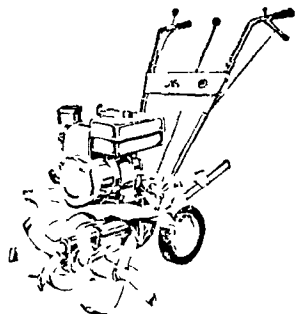
